If found guilty, you shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding S\$10,000 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 6 months or to both for first offence; or to a fine not exceeding S\$20,000 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 12 months or to both for subsequent offence.
3. If you are entering or leaving Singapore carrying a total value of Physical Currency and Bearer Negotiable Instruments (CBNI) exceeding S\$20,000 (or its equivalent in a foreign currency), please submit [a cash \(CBNI\) declaration](#).

4. If you are bringing in any item, or carrying an item for someone, but you do not know what it contains, you must declare the item at the Red Channel.

5. All arriving travellers are required to declare and pay the duty and Goods and Services Tax (GST) on all dutiable and taxable goods exceeding their duty-free concession and GST relief.
