Your Vehicle SBT3280J Has Been Deregistered

The above-mentioned vehicle was deregistered on 07 Nov 2024. If the vehicle is yet to be disposed of, you should do so by 07 Dec 2024. Scrap it (including the engine and chassis) at an LTA-appointed scrapyard or submit to LTA documentary proof that the vehicle has been permanently exported out of Singapore. Otherwise, it is an offence and the penalty is a fine of up to \$2,000 and imprisonment of up to 3 months for the first offence. Subsequent offences carry heavier penalties.

We have granted the following rebate(s) to you. You can use the rebate(s) if there are no outstanding matters with the vehicle, e.g. there are no road tax arrears, the vehicle financing is settled, you have submitted documentary proof that the vehicle has been permanently exported out of Singapore to LTA, etc.

- Encash, transfer or offset fees on your new car with the PARF/COE rebate(s).
- Use your COE rebate to offset the Prevailing Quota Premium (PQP) when you renew the COE of your existing vehicle.

Any unused portion of the road tax will be refunded to you.

PROCEDURE TO DISPOSE OF YOUR VEHICLE

There are three ways to dispose of your vehicle:

- a. Scrap it at an LTA-appointed scrapyard
- b. Store it at an LTA-appointed EPZ, pending export
- c. Export it

If you scrap your vehicle at an LTA-appointed scrapyard or store it at an LTA-appointed EPZ, the scrapyard or EPZ will send the disposal records to LTA on your behalf. If you export the vehicle, you will need to submit the export documents to LTA.

a. Scrap Vehicle at LTA-appointed Scrapyard

Send your vehicle to an LTA-appointed scrapyard. The person disposing of the vehicle at the scrapyard must bring his/her physical NRIC or long-term pass card, or show his/her Digital Identity Card (Digital IC) launched via the Singpass app. Photos, screenshots or videos of the identity card, pass card or Digital IC will not be accepted. If the vehicle is already deregistered, it cannot be driven there, as it is an offence to use a deregistered vehicle. Tow or arrange for your vehicle to be transported there.

The disposal details will be submitted on your behalf to LTA.

b. Store Vehicle in LTA-appointed Export Processing Zone (EPZ), Pending Export

Arrange with an LTA-appointed EPZ operator to store your vehicle.

Send your vehicle to an LTA-appointed EPZ. The person disposing of the vehicle at the EPZ must bring his/her physical NRIC or long-term pass card, or show his/her Digital Identity Card (Digital IC) launched via the Singpass app. Photos, screenshots or videos of the identity card, pass card or Digital IC will not be accepted. If the vehicle is already deregistered, it cannot be driven there, as it is an offence to use a deregistered vehicle. Tow or arrange for your vehicle to be transported there.

The disposal details will be submitted on your behalf to LTA.

A vehicle can be stored in an EPZ for up to 12 months. Once your vehicle exits the EPZ, you must submit the export documents to LTA via the EPZ operator within 14 days.

c. Export Vehicle

Export the vehicle yourself, or engage a motor dealer to help you. Use a CaseTrust-SVTA-accredited motor dealer for greater assurance.

After your vehicle is exported, submit the export documents to LTA online at onemotoring.lta.gov.sg > Digital Services > Upload Disposal Documents. The export documents you need to submit are:

- Singapore Customs Cargo Clearance Permit (CCP) and **duly endorsed** non-negotiable Bill of Lading, for vehicles exported by ocean.

- Singapore Customs CCP and **duly endorsed** Malaysian Customs' Inward Declaration Permit, for vehicles exported by land.

The engine and chassis numbers of the vehicles must be included in these documents.

Alternatively, you can submit a copy of the foreign registration document(s) as proof of export.

Note:

You have to pay any outstanding road tax arrears. Any unused road tax will be automatically refunded to the last-registered owner.

If you wish to retain the registration number from your deregistered vehicle to be used on another vehicle under your name, you must do so within 1 month of deregistering the vehicle.
