Brief Details.

On the above mentioned date and time, I was driving my vehicle SLK520R along Dunearn Rd City with a passenger. I was driving along the third lane. Near to the Shell Petrol kiosk, I signal I intended to change to the second lane. I proceeded to merge into the second lane. Suddenly, SLL9957A came from my right and into the second lane in front of me. I drove along as there was a collision. About six minutes later, the same vehicle abruptly cut into my lane again and stopped my vehicle. I managed to stop in time. The driver, a male Chinese in his fifties alleged that I knocked his vehicle. I made a check on the front right side of my vehicle and it was slightly damaged. I told him of the accident and both parties left. I decided not to make a Police report or claim from insurance as I am sorry that he is a private hire car driver in his fifties. Thinking that he is trying to make a living, I don't want to claim against him.
