ACCIDENT INVOLVING SLJ 3710U & SGD 6696Z ON 11/12/2017

We refer to the above matter.

TP reported that OI was making a sudden lane change without checking oncoming vehicle and collided with his vehicle.

OI reported that he signalled left and filtering to the left lane. While he was filtering towards the left, the vehicle in front suddenly filtered out and stopped. He then stopped his vehicle and being hit by TP from behind which was unable to stop on time.

As per OI video footage captured by rear camera, at the time of the collision OI completed changing lane rear ended by TP vehicle.

The circumstances of the accident and available information in hand, it's more appropriate with BOLA scenario 27 and liability is against TP.

Kindly advise whether we may proceed to reject Third Party claim.
