Reference to your letter dated 13 December 2017 on the aforesaid claim, here are the evidence of the damages on both cars.

Attached please find a voice recording of the conversation between my husband, Patrick and I with Janice after the accident. Janice had made admission that she jammed her brakes because the car in front of her had done so.

Her cutting into my lane suddenly from my blind-spot w/o signalling seeing the gap between me and the car in front of me narrowed the safety distance significantly. Her sudden jamming of brakes thereafter resulted in this accident because I could not stop my car on time.

That is all that we are submitting for this 3rd party accident claim.
