FACTS OF CASE:

I am the owner and driver of the vehicle bearing registration number SGL 3534 K involved in an accident on 2/2/18 at 0330 hours at the North-South Highway (Southbound) from Kuala Lumpur heading to Singapore.

1/2/18
I was alone. I went to Kuala Lumpur (KL) on 31/01/18 at 1100 hours to visit some friends. I left KL at about 0000 hours on 02/02/18 and was en route to Singapore via the North-South Highway. I was nearing the Muar Exit. I was travelling in the 1st lane at 110 kmph. The traffic was light, weather was clear and the road surface was dry.

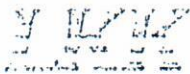
I remember that I had overtaken a Malaysian-registered lorry on the 2nd lane. Suddenly, my car had flipped and rolled over many times before coming to a stop. The car was overturned at the final rest position. All my airbags had deployed and all 6 windows had shattered. While the car was overturning I remember the lorry was pushing my car forwards. By the time I regained composure, I realized that my hands and head were bleeding and I had suffered abrasions and felt pain.

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all over my body. My 1st reaction was to unbuckle my seatbelt and got out of my car as quickly as I could. I managed to unbuckle my seatbelt and crawled out the car and stopped at the side of the highway. A few people had gathered at the accident scene. ~~The driver of the lorry approached me x/~~ A guy who could speak Malay and was Chinese told me that the lorry driver had hit onto my rear and it could not brake on time even though my car was rolling and kept pushing my car forwards. The police arrived shortly after, followed by an ambulance and a tow truck. Paramedics examined me and help tend to my wounds. I remember signing a form to refusal of medical treatment by conveyance to a local hospital. After that the ambulance left. The tow truck personnel helped to overturn my car. I then borrowed a torchlight from them and searched my car for my passport. While waiting for the car to be overturned I searched for my personal belongings which may have fallen out of the car. I found my in-vehicle camera and threw it back into my car after it was overturned. I felt giddy and pain all over and could not understand what they were talking as they were speaking in Malay. The police and tow truck left with my car. I was brought to a police station by someone I don't remember. The police officers asked for my IC and driving licence. I gave them the cards together with my passport. They took down my report but they did not give me any copy. By that time I was in tremendous pain and did not remember or realize what had happened. Later the same guy who brought me to the police station brought me to the tow truck. At the accident scene I used my handphone and called my son and asked him to fetch me at JB. The tow truck personnel charged me RM2000 to tow my car to JB customs where the car will be transferred to another tow truck and brought to Singapore. I did not take any accident scene photos as I was too much in pain. The tow truck personnel gave me a piece of paper with ABP 9463 written on it. He said it was the lorry registration number. I followed the tow truck to a Shell station before the JB customs while waiting for my son and mom to fetch me. They reached the Shell station at 1100 hours. My son paid the tow-truck personnel S\$600 and told him to tow the car to S & H Motor in Singapore. My son brought me to Singapore General Hospital (SGH) and I was admitted by 1300 hours. I stayed for 1 day and was discharged on 03/02/18 and given 14 days of medical leave.

My son informed me that he went to S & H Motor to view the car and told me that he did not find my in-vehicle camera in the car.

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FACTS OF CASE:

He brought me to S&H Motor on 07/02/18 to view the car. I also couldn't find the in-vehicle camera despite searching. We then went to the Thomson Police Post at 1340 hours to make a police report and returned to S&H Motor to pass them a copy and to file the insurance report at 1608 hours.

As I still felt pain in my chest and right rib I returned to S&H on 05/02/18 to see the doctor. X-rays taken showed there was no fracture and I was prescribed painkillers and given 2 days of medical leave from 05/02/18 to 07/02/18. The next day I got a call from a S&H doctor who informed me that I had a slight fracture at the right rib but it was not serious and that it would heal on its own.

There was no problem with my car while I was driving it. My last servicing was done in JB every 10,000 km but I do not keep the receipts.

I wish to state that I did not consume alcohol and/or take any medication that may impair my ability to drive at the dated time of accident.
