

We refer to the above-captioned.

This matter has been escalated by M/s LKK Auto Consultant for our further deliberation.

Having carefully studied the matter, we regret to inform that we are maintaining our assessment which is liability is not in our favor based on the following reasons:-

- 1. Onus is very much on vehicle approaching the major road to ensure that the traffic is clear before proceeding and should give way to oncoming vehicles travelling on the major road.
- 2. Based on the enclosed still shot, the marking on the lane you were travelling is for 'left turn only', however based on your accident statement, you were making a right turn instead. Even if you are allowed to make a right turn, our assessment still remains.
- 3. We enclosed herewith video footage provided by SLM3958G for your easy reference. As the traffic ahead is clear, he has precedence to move forward.
- 4. We also enclosed herewith 3 scenarios extracted from the Motor Accident Guideline; it serves as a guide to the application for the apportionment of liability by the state court. Liability apportionment is 80% is against the turning party, which is according to our assessment of the accident.





Reason(s): Driver Y on 80 20 the major road has right of way, but should keep a lookout for vehicles turning into the major road from an adjoining minor road.
