DE-REGISTRATION STATUS OF VEHICLE SJW9125A

The above-mentioned vehicle was de-registered on 22 May 2018. If the vehicle has yet to be disposed of, you should by no later than 22 Jun 2018, scrap it (including the engine and chassis) at an Appointed Scrapyard or submit to LTA, valid documentary proof that the vehicle has been permanently exported out of Singapore. Otherwise, it constitutes an offence under the Road Traffic Act and you may be prosecuted in Court.

2. We have granted the following rebate(s), where applicable, to you. You may use the rebate(s) if there are no outstanding matters with the vehicle, e.g. no road tax arrears, submitted valid documentary proof that the vehicle has been permanently exported out of Singapore to LTA etc.

The COE rebate can also be used to offset the Prevailing Quota Premium (PQP) payable for revalidating the COE of a vehicle that is currently registered in your name. You may also transfer the PARF/COE rebate(s) together or separately to a third party. A fee of \$15.00 is payable for each transfer.

4. Alternatively, you may apply to encash the PARF/COE rebate(s) before the expiry of the rebate(s). You can download the application form (Form FR02) for encashment of the rebate(s) from <http://www.onemotoring.com.sg> and mail the completed Form FR02 to LTA, 10 Sin Ming Drive, Singapore 575701, Attn: VRL Service Operations Division, at least 2 weeks before the expiry date of your PARF/COE rebate(s). For your convenience, you may also login to e-Services@ONE.MOTORING (Vehicle Hub > Update Owner Particulars) using your SingPass 2FA or CorpPass 2FA to register your Refund Bank Account for GIRO refund BEFORE applying online for the encashment (Ownership > PARF/COE Rebate > Apply to encash rebate).
5. Any unused portion of the road tax will be refunded to you automatically.
6. Please note that a separate PIN is required to transfer or split the PARF/COE rebate via the Internet or at our Electronic Service Agents. Before you perform these transactions, please request for your PINs via <http://www.onemotoring.com.sg> or visit our office at 10 Sin Ming Drive, Singapore 575701, VRL Service Operations Division.

From 15 February 2017, you do not need to display road tax disc on the windscreen of your vehicle. LTA has stopped issuing physical road tax discs as part of our efforts to streamline our processes. Please ensure that your original motor insurance certificate is readily available in your vehicle at all times. If you are driving into Malaysia, you are advised to carry printed proof of the validity of your road tax in your vehicle.

PROCEDURE TO DE-REGISTER VEHICLE

Step 1: Decide whether you want to dispose of your vehicle by scrap or export, and whether you want to do it yourself or engage the services of a motor dealer. You are advised to approach a motor dealer who is CaseTrust-SVTA accredited for greater assurance when transacting with them. For more details on the CaseTrust-SVTA accreditation scheme, please visit <http://www.CaseTrust.org.sg>.

Step 2: Dispose of the vehicle by any of the following methods:

- **Scraping of Vehicle at an LTA-authorised Scrapyard**
 - Obtain a Transaction Pin (TPin) from LTA (via <http://www.onemotoring.com.sg>) if the vehicle is to be scrapped **before de-registration date**:
 - i) You may use the TPin to apply via <http://www.onemotoring.com.sg> to appoint a submitter to scrap the vehicle at the scrapyard. The submitter (original identification document required for verification) should ensure that the vehicle is scrapped within 5 calendar days of your application; or
 - ii) Bring the TPin to the scrapyard with the original identification document of the submitter for verification; and
 - iii) Submit a duly completed Form D01 to the scrapyard operator.
 - If the vehicle is already **de-registered**, it must be towed to the scrapyard with the following documents:-
 - i) Original identification document of the submitter; and
 - ii) A duly completed Form D01;
 - The disposal details will be transmitted on your behalf to LTA.

- **Storage of Vehicle in an LTA-authorised Export Processing Zone (EPZ)**
 - Please liaise with an LTA-authorised EPZ operator for storage of your vehicles.
 - Obtain a Transaction Pin (TPin) from LTA (via <http://www.onemotoring.com.sg>) **before the vehicle's de-registration date**.
 - i) You may use the TPin to apply via <http://www.onemotoring.com.sg> to appoint a submitter to send your vehicle to the EPZ. The submitter (original identification document required for verification) should ensure that the vehicle is stored in the EPZ within 5 calendar days of your application; or
 - ii) Bring the TPin to the EPZ with the original identification document of the submitter for verification; and
 - iii) Submit a duly completed Form D01 to the EPZ operator.
 - If the vehicle is already **de-registered**, it must be towed to the EPZ with the following documents:-
 - i) Original identification document of the submitter; and
 - ii) A duly completed Form D01;
 - The disposal details will be transmitted on your behalf to LTA.

- **Exporting A Vehicle**
 - Upon export of the vehicle, submit to LTA the following documents with the duly completed Form D01:-
 - i) Original identification document of the registered owner and submitter; and
 - ii) Duly endorsed originals of the Singapore Customs Cargo Clearance Permit (CCP) and non-negotiable Bill of Lading (for ocean freight); or
 - iii) Duly endorsed originals of Singapore Customs CCP and Malaysian Customs' Inward Declaration Permit (for export by land); or
 - iv) Original copy of foreign registration document(s).

Note:

- If your vehicle's de-registration application is received after its road tax/lay up/road tax exemption period has expired, you will have to pay the arrears of road tax and late renewal fees, where applicable.
- A refund of the residual road tax, if any, will be effected upon de-registration of the vehicle and it will be made to the last registered owner. No application is necessary.
- Any registered owner who wishes to retain the registration number for use on a new vehicle to be registered in his name should do so before de-registering his old vehicle.
- A Transaction PIN is required to de-register a vehicle. Please request for your Transaction PIN at <http://www.onemotoring.com.sg> (My Account > Transaction PIN > Request for PIN) using your SingPass 2FA or CorpPass 2FA.
