On 07 March 2018 (Wednesday) at or about 10.31 p.m., the Deceased was riding his motorcycle, along Nicoll Drive towards the direction of Changi Coast Road. The Potential Defendant (B1) was driving motor car, **SGH 1678 M** and exited carpark number 5, making a right turn into Nicoll Drive towards Loyang Avenue. The Deceased was unable to brake in time and collided onto the right side of the said motor car, which was travelling from the Deceased's left to right side.

2 As a result of the accident, the Deceased sustained multiple injuries and was conveyed to the Changi General Hospital by ambulance in a critical state. He succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced dead in the hospital (A&E) at 11.30 p.m on the same day.

(a) Case IAFP-IB-20180312-Mechanical Inspection of Motor Car, SLN 9029 T (TP/IP/06231/2018)

On 3 March 2018 at about 5.58 pm, the Potential Defendant (B1) was driving motor car **SLN 9029 T** along Yishun Ring Road towards Yishun Avenue 11 on the left of 2 lanes road. He claimed A1 who was travelling in front of his vehicle made a sudden brake and stopped. As such, he made a lane change to the right to overtake A1. In the midst of overtaking, suddenly the Deceased crossed the road in front of A1 and appeared on his left to right. B1 could not avoid and collided onto the Deceased's right side. Due to the accident, the Deceased was injured and was conveyed conscious to Khoo Teck Puat Hospital (KTPH) by ambulance. The Deceased was warded at ICU Ward B36 Bed 15. However, the Deceased then succumbed to her injuries in hospital and was pronounced dead on 4 March 2018 by Dr Cadence Wee at 1228 hrs at KTPH ICU.

(b) Case IAFP-IB-20180312-Mechanical Inspection of Motorcycle, FBG 7253 E (TP/IP/16203/2018)

On 11 March 2018 (Sunday), sometime before 8.23 a.m., the Deceased was riding motorcycle, **FBG 7253 E**, along PIE towards the direction of Airport, near the 18.8 km mark, lamp post 916, when he lost control of the motorcycle, side-swiped the left guard railing and skidded. Due to the impact, the Deceased was flung over the railing and landed on the grass verge while the motorcycle laid on the road shoulder. A passer-by stopped by the accident after noticing the damaged motorcycle. Upon further checks, the passer-by found the Deceased in an unconscious state with injuries to the face and body. As a result of the accident, the Deceased sustained multiple injuries and was pronounced dead at scene at 8.48 a.m.
