We refer to the above matter.

TP driver reported that he was driving along the middle lane of Clemenceau Avenue North(side road), when traffic light turn green, he inched forward as his cars infront move forward, TP driver alleged our Insured not in 3rd or 4th lane(assumed he alleged OI come from 2nd lane from right), our insured move in to 3rd lane as 3rd lane was empty. He was practically stationary and felt our insured was inched too close and collided into his front fender and bumper. TP has no CCTV, only have accident scene photo(attached).

Our insured reported that he was driven along 3rd lane(total 4 lane) from right of Newton Circle roundabout, traffic light was in Insured favor, while crossing the yellow box, suddenly, a car came out from side road (Clemenceau Avenue North) and collided into his left portion of his vehicle.

Accident occurred in 3rd lane(total 4 lane) from right of Newton Circle roundabout after the yellow box.

Our Insured driven along 3^{rd} lane from right of Newton Circle roundabout(OI video footage proof that) has the right of way as our insured on the main road. TP inched out from side road(Clemenceau Avenue North). TP should not move into yellow box as the traffic light was green for vehicle along the main road.

Given the above, we will like to propose to reject the claim.
