We refer to the above matter

The third party reported that he driving along toward KPE, before reaching merging lane, OI squeeze into TP's lane and brush against TP vehicle.

Insured reported that he was entering KPE tunnel, heavy traffic and is a merging lane. TP did not give way to OI and brush against OI's vehicle

We had spoken to Insured, he dispute liability (enclosed email), we explained to OI that base on the reports accident happen at merging lane, is a 50/50 case both party should bear some liability.
