I would like to surface about the LKK inspection of motor car, SLW9010Z, vide TP/IP/70101/2018

2 This is a case of a Minor RTA involving the said motor car and a motor van which caused a lamppost to be damaged. The driver of the said motor car claimed that there was a mechanical fault to his motor car which caused him to lose control of the motor car thus resulting in the accident.

3 The accident took place along Tampines Road on 22/12/2018 and the LKK inspection request was applied on 24/12/2018.

4 I had just made a check with LKK and spoke to Sherwin. He informed me that motor car, SLW9010Z, has yet to be inspected. He said that he will try to get the inspection done within 2 weeks from today.

5 May I get your assistance to try and expedite the inspection for the said motor car? The owner of the motor car had asked to get his motor car back.
