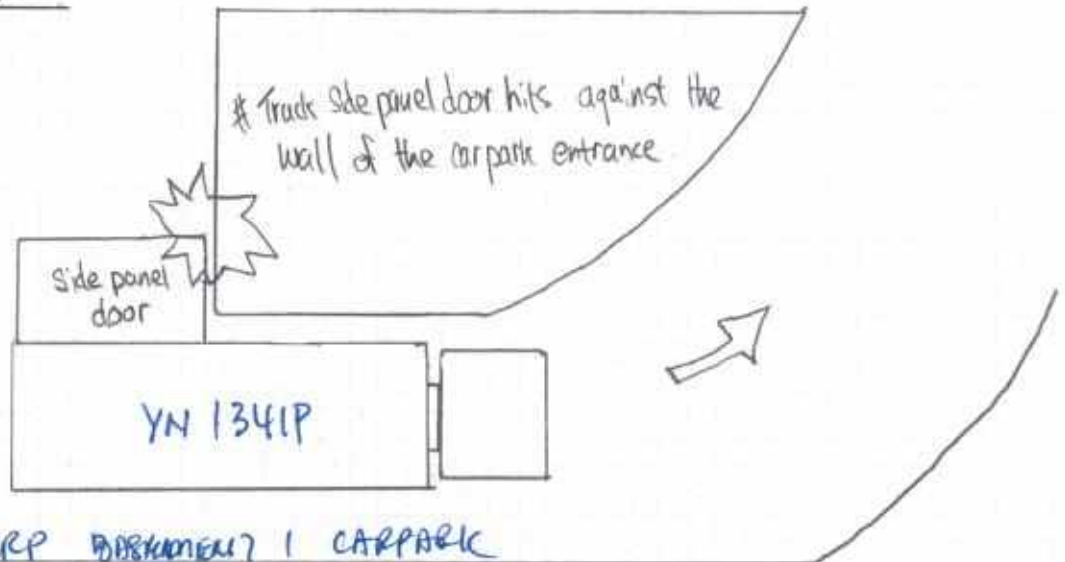

DESCRIBE CIRCUMSTANCES OF THE ACCIDENT

On 25th of February, 1040hrs Low Guan Chai was driving off from Mediacorp carpark to rove for campaign. However, he forgets to close the side panel of the truck after meeting with the client. Guan Chai begins to drive off and exit the carpark. While the truck is exiting carpark, the near left side panel collide onto the wall beside the carpark entrance causing the near left side panel to almost dislodge from the vehicle and the impact causes damages on the wall in the B1 carpark. The truck quickly reverse and park safely to access the damages. Guan Chai then call up his superior to assess the situation.

Due to campaign ongoing, the side panel was safely dislodge & place inside the truck and the truck immediately drove to our production house for rectification at 1245hrs to 1640hrs. Production then build a plywood to cover up the opening for temporary measure until the campaign is over and the truck then drive over to contractor's place to repaired the left near side panel.

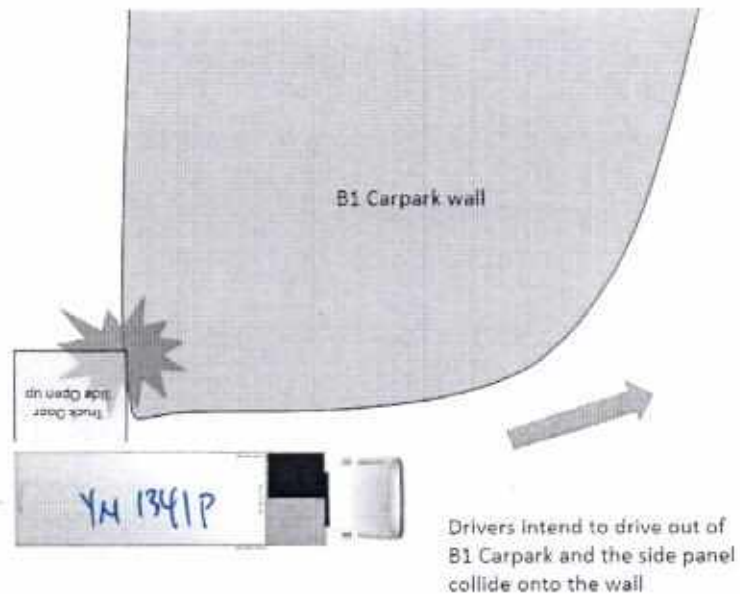

Incident Statement Report from Low Guan Chai:

- 0930hrs - Guan Chai report to Mediacorp Campus and wait for the client to come at 10am for truck viewing
- 0950hrs - Guan Chai went down to B1 and prepare the truck, he opens up only the rear door of the truck for the client to view the interior.
- 1000hrs - Client reach at the Reception for registering and Kelvin Lau, Kheng Keong & Weixiong escort client down to B1 carpark to view the physical truck.
- 1010hrs to 1040hrs - Discussion with clients on the truck activation for the next campaign happening in April/ May. Client brought their contractor down and view the interior and saw that the truck side panel was able to open and requested us to open up the rear side door for them to visualize how to decorate the interior of the truck and Guan Chai assist to set up the staircase for the client to climb up the truck.
- 1040hrs - Meeting ended with client and client move off to Level 1 to exchange back the visitor pass while left with Kheng Keong, Weixiong and Guan Chai still at the truck assisting with the loading of staircase and checking of the truck exterior.
- 1043hrs - Kheng Keong & Weixiong returned back to level 9 to continue on work.
- 1045hrs - Guan Chai begins to drive off for roving, but however he forgets to close the side panel and start to move off to exit the B1 carpark.
- 1045hrs to 1050hrs - While the truck exiting carpark and the rear left side panel collide onto the wall beside the carpark entrance causing the door panel to almost dislodge from vehicle and the side panel also causes damages on the wall in the B1 carpark.

1050hrs to 1100hrs - Guan Chai was shocked from the impact and quickly get down the truck and realise that the side panel has hit the wall. Guan Chai then quickly reverse the truck and park beside the parking lot to avoid any congestion in the carpark to access the damages.

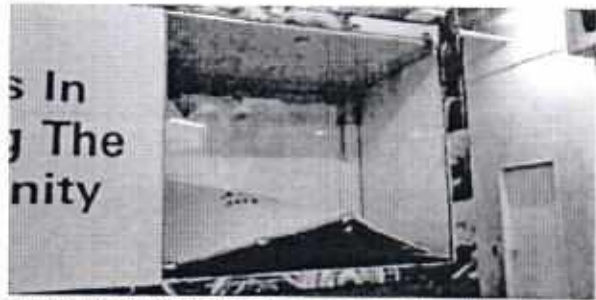


#Damages of the side panel – 3 out of 4 hinges was dislodged.

1100hrs - Guan Chai immediately reports to Weixiong on the accident and Weixiong quickly make a trip down to B1 carpark to access the situation. As the situation is bad, Weixiong also calls in to Kheng Keong to come down to carpark to assist the situation. On the time of Weixiong arrival, estate management, cisco security and facilities management came down to B1 carpark to access the incident. Facilities management also assist to check on the CCTV on how the incident happen and report to Weixiong that the rear side panel of the door was not close and causing the side panel to collide onto the carpark entrance wall.

1200hrs - Ops team decided to dislodge the suspended damaged door due to safety as the door is secured by only one hinge and secondly we need to rectify the door as part of the business continuity. There is an ongoing campaign as the truck is scheduled for video filming on the following day. Ops team quickly contacted the vendor to come down to Mediacorp Campus and rectified the side panel door but however the contractors can only come down after 2pm which the timing is very crucial for the truck to get rectified before second day filming. Thus the Ops team brainstorm with our in-house contractor help and dislodged the side panel safety. The side panel is then place back into the truck rear and is securely tied to the truck body structure so that the driver can drives off to the production house to get the truck rectified.

1245hrs to 1640hrs - Rectification at production house. Production house measured the truck and place a plywood to cover up the opening for temporary measures. They secured the plywood by using bracket and secure onto our truck interior flooring and ceiling. After which they will sand off the uneven areas and apply new visual sticker onto the plywood.

1740hrs - Guan Chai reached the production house and inspect the truck for anymore rectifications that needs to be done.

1750hrs - Guan Chai drives off from production house and drive back to Mediacorp Campus to park the truck.

1830hrs - Guan Chai reached Mediacorp Campus at 1810hrs
