ACCIDENT ON 14-09-2015 ALONG MURAI FARMWAY NEAR MURAI LODGE INVOLVING AN UNKNOWN VEHICLE AND INJURED PEDESTRIAN - MR MUTHAIAH SELVAMUTHU

We refer to your letter of 26-09-2017 rejecting the revised claim of MUTHAIAH SELVAMUTHU ("the Appellant").

- 2. We appreciate your help to obtain from the Appellant's solicitors the following documents for our assessment:
 - a) Copy of a sketch plan showing:
 - i. the direction which the Appellant was walking in relation to Murai Farmway, Lamppost 37 and Lim Chu Kang Road;
 - ii. the path travelled by the unknown vehicle to knock the Appellant's head on the right; and
 - iii. the orientation which the Appellant was lying on the grass patch so that only his left leg was crushed by the unknown vehicle.

The reason being that the sketch in the police report does not provide the requested information for us to understand how the unknown vehicle knocked the Appellant's head on the <u>right</u> but crushed the Appellant's <u>left</u> leg and leaving his right leg was unharmed.

b) Photographs of the accident scene showing tire tracks on the grass patch or on the road to show the path travelled by the unknown lorry to crush the Appellant's left leg.
