a) Case IAFP-IB-20190908 - Mechanical Inspection of Police Motor Car, QX297H (TP/IP/54567/2019)

On 30 August 2019 (Friday) sometime before 4.45 pm, the police motor car, QX297H (B1), was travelling straight along Bishan St 2 towards the direction of Marymount Rd on lane 2 of the 2-lanes road and was on his way to Tanglin Div.
