LETTER OF AUTHORITY & INDEMNITY

1. I/We, the owner of vehicle no. 8JU4658Y hereby instruct and authorize you to commence repairs to the said vehicle. I/We clearly understand that the Manufacturer's Normal Warranty maybe void due to the accident repair done at your workshop.
2. You are further authorized to appoint solicitors on my/our behalf and give the solicitors full instructions as if the appointment is made and instructions are given by me/us with respect to the conduct of my/our claim against the third party driver and/or his insurers including if necessary, to commence legal proceedings in Court in my/our name against the third party.
3. You have my/our full authority to negotiate a settlement with the third party and/or his insurers on such terms as you deem fit or to instruct my/our solicitors as per paragraph 2 to do the same. Upon settlement of my claim, you are authorized to sign any Discharge Voucher or any document to confirm my acceptance of the settlement as full and final discharge of my claim, on my behalf.
4. Upon resolving my/our claim, you are authorized to agree with my/our solicitors on the amount of their professional costs and disbursements of acting for me/us and to receive payment of the balance of the settlement sum on my/our behalf directly into your account.
5. In the event that I/we am/are required to attend at my/our solicitors' office or to attend Court in connection with my/our claim, I/we shall render full co-operation.
6. In the event that my/our claim against the third party and/or his insurers is not successful or cannot be proceeded with, I/we authorize you to make a claim against my/our own insurers for the cost of repairs and any other losses recoverable under my/our policy of insurance. In this respect, I/we understand and accept that the excess amount applicable under the policy of insurance shall be borne by me/us. I/We shall also be personally liable to bear all Legal Costs incurred by you in claiming back for the repair costs by your Solicitors.
7. If for whatever reason, my/our insurer(s) or the third party insurer(s) reject my/our claim for indemnity for the cost of repairs and/or any losses recoverable under the policy of insurance or make an offer to pay less than the amount claimed by you, I/we agree and undertake to pay the full amount of your repair bill and survey fees and any other expenses reasonably incurred on my/our behalf or to pay you the difference in amount, as the case may be.
8. ***I/We hereby confirm I/we have read and understand the contents of this document and the same. I/We acknowledge receipt of a copy of the same.***

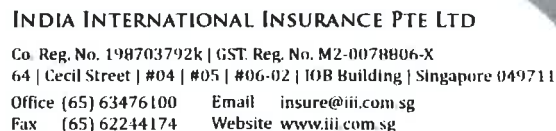

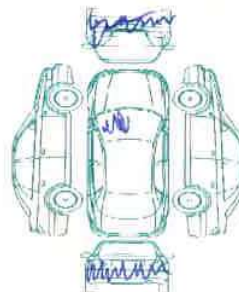

Your Vehicle SJU4658Y Has Been Deregistered

The above-mentioned vehicle was deregistered on 14 Nov 2019. If the vehicle is yet to be disposed of, you should do so by 14 Dec 2019. Scrap it (including the engine and chassis) at an LTA-authorized scrapyard or submit to LTA documentary proof that the vehicle has been permanently exported out of Singapore. Otherwise, it is an offence and the penalty is a fine of up to \$2,000 and imprisonment of up to 3 months for the first offence. Subsequent offences carry heavier penalties.

We have granted the following rebate(s) to you. You can use the rebate(s) if there are no outstanding matters with the vehicle, e.g. there are no road tax arrears, the vehicle financing is settled, you have submitted documentary proof that the vehicle has been permanently exported out of Singapore to LTA, etc.

- Use your PARF/COE rebate(s) before it expires:
 - PARF expires on 13 Nov 2020.
 - COE expires on 13 Nov 2020.
- Encash, transfer or offset fees on your new car with the PARF/COE rebate(s).
- Use your COE rebate to offset the Prevailing Quota Premium (PQP) when you renew the COE of your existing vehicle.

Any unused portion of the road tax will be refunded to you.

PROCEDURE TO DISPOSE OF YOUR VEHICLE

There are three ways to dispose of your vehicle:

- Scrap it at an LTA-authorised scrapyard
- Store it at an LTA-authorised EPZ, pending export
- Export it

If you scrap your vehicle at a scrapyard or store it at an EPZ, the scrapyard or EPZ will send the disposal records to LTA on your behalf. If you export the vehicle, you will need to submit the export documents to LTA.

• **Scrap Vehicle at LTA-authorised Scrapyard**

Tow or transport your vehicle to an LTA-authorised scrapyard. The person disposing of the vehicle at the scrapyard must bring his/her original NRIC or Employment/Immigration pass card (issued by MOM or ICA). The vehicle cannot be driven there, as it is an offence to use a deregistered vehicle.

The disposal details will be submitted on your behalf to LTA.

• **Store Vehicle in LTA-authorised Export Processing Zone (EPZ), Pending Export**

Arrange with an LTA-authorised EPZ operator to store your vehicle.

Tow or transport your vehicle to an LTA-authorised EPZ. The person disposing of the vehicle at the EPZ must bring his/her original NRIC or Employment/Immigration pass card (issued by MOM or ICA). The vehicle cannot be driven there, as it is an offence to use a deregistered vehicle.

The disposal details will be submitted on your behalf to LTA.

A vehicle can be stored in an EPZ for up to 12 months. Once your vehicle exits the EPZ, you must submit the export documents to LTA via the EPZ operator within 14 days.

• **Export Vehicle**

Export the vehicle yourself, or engage a motor dealer to help you. Use a CaseTrust-SVTA-accredited motor dealer for greater assurance.

After your vehicle is exported, submit the export documents to LTA online at www.onemotoring.com.sg > Digital Services > Upload Disposal Documents. The export documents you need to submit are:

- Duly endorsed* Singapore Customs Cargo Clearance Permit (CCP) and non-negotiable Bill of Lading, for vehicles exported by ocean.
- Duly endorsed* Singapore Customs CCP and Malaysian Customs' Inward Declaration Permit, for vehicles exported by land.

The engine and chassis numbers of the vehicles must be included in these documents. The CCP need not be endorsed if the vehicle is declared as "containerised".

Alternatively, you can submit a copy of the foreign registration document(s) as proof of export.

Note:

You have to pay any outstanding road tax arrears. Any unused road tax will be automatically refunded to the last-registered owner.

If you wish to retain the registration number from your deregistered vehicle to be used on another vehicle under your name, you must do so within 1 month of deregistering the vehicle.
