Dear Sirs/Mdm,

We refer to the above matter.

Third party reported that he was stuck at Woodlands Centre Road due to heavy traffic congestion. He was on the right most lane. While it finally started moving, third party started to drive forward, our insured on his left cut into his lane and hit onto third party car. Third party horn but our insured continued to drive off.

Our insured reported that he stopped his car in the yellow box of the junction and third party on his right was trying to squeeze into his lane. As soon as the car in front move, insured heard a bang sound at the right of his car, insured did not stop the car to held up the existing heavy traffic. After he reached home, he checked his car and realised that there is a dent.

Attached is a copy of video footage submitted by third party for your easy reference. From the video footage, we observe that third party was on the right most lane while our insured vehicle was on his left. While the front vehicles started to move, insured and third party were also moving forward and both parties collided onto each other's. We would like to propose 50/50 on this matter as we are of the view that both parties should exercise caution.
