SKETCH PLAN


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8. **Consent under the Personal Data Protection Act (PDPA)**


I understand, acknowledge, agree and consent that:

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

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

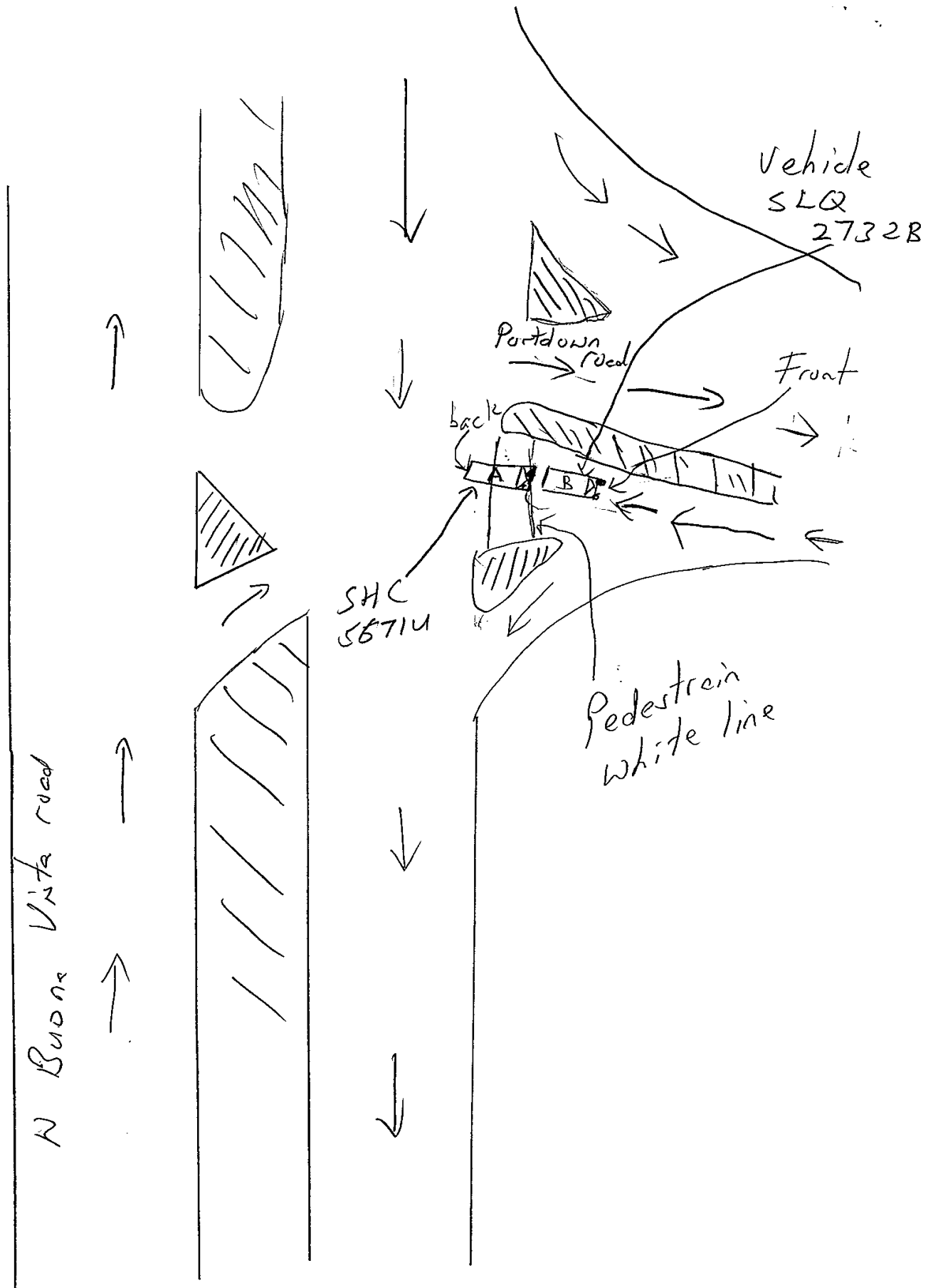

I am a Trans cab taxi driver and my vehicle number is SHC 5671U.

On 15th April at about 4.55pm, I was driving (SHC 5671U) along North Buona Vista road and wanted to turn right toward Portdown road.

I was at the junction along North Buona Vista road waiting for the traffic light to turn green before I could turn right toward Portdown road.

There was already a car (SLQ 2732B) at the same junction traffic light also wanting to turn right toward Portdown road and I was behind this car (SLQ 2732 B).

When the traffic light turn green, the car (SLQ 2732B) start to turn right toward Portdown road. I then also followed the car (SLQ 2732B) in front and turn right toward Portdown road.

The car (SLQ 2732 B) all of a sudden jam brake his car just after he past the white pedestrian line and due to his sudden jam brake, I was not able to stop in time and I hit the back of his car (SLQ 2732B).

The vehicle owner (SLQ 2732B) stopped his car and I also stopped my car and I asked him why do he all of a sudden jam brake his car and he said that he had drive into the wrong lane which is an incoming lane.

I did not realise that the car (SLQ 2732B) was driving into the wrong lane, it was very naturally reaction for me to follow the car (SLQ 2732B) in front as he wanted to turn right toward Portdown road which is also the same road that I wanted to take.

I told him that he should not have jam brake his car and should still drive ahead when there is no incoming car and there is nothing he could do. He was not able to reply me. And because of his jam brake I was not able to brake my vehicle on time. I have a passenger who also told him that he should not jam brake his car. And he just kept quite.

A short while later, there was an incoming car. I then told him that we have to move our vehicles so that not to cause any obstruction. I then reversed my car (SHC 5671U) carefully and drive toward the correct lane (Portdown road) and he also reversed his car and drive toward the correct lane and he then parked his vehicle in front of me.

He then took his handphone and took some pictures and I took picture of his car (SLQ 2732B) and we also exchange our driving license particulars and after this, I drove off.

I wish to say that, the vehicle car (SLQ 2732B) owner although he had drive into the wrong lane which is due to his mistake, he should not have jam brake his vehicle and instead he should carry on driving as there was no incoming car at the point of the accident. Reason being, there is nothing he could do. He could not reverse or make a U-turn because I was behind him. And due to his carelessness which he jam brake his car, there is no way for me to know that he had turn toward the incoming lane as I was behind him and do not expect him to make such mistake. It is a very naturally reaction for any drivers to follow the car in front whether it is turning right or left or even going straight.
