


SKETCH PLAN



DESCRIBE CIRCUMSTANCES OF THE ACCIDENT

<p>It was drizzling and the road conditions were wet. I was driving northbound along Sembawang Rd, at the junction with Jalan Mata Ayer. I was wearing a mask while driving. At the junction, I did not notice the traffic light had been red as I was turning red. I braked when I noticed the cars on the left stopped, I being on the right-most lane. However, the car SKS6578P had already started turning into Sembawang Rd, and I could not brake in time to avoid SKE3769P. The front-right of SKS6578P collided into the rear-right side of SKE3769P, at around the over-sight door handle. Both cars stopped for drivers to exchange particulars.</p>

In the absence of any supporting evidence to support your client's accident version, we opine that liability is down against your client under BOLA 5.
