a) Case IAFP-IB-20200605 - Mechanical Inspection of Motorcycle, FBG2618U (TP/IP/24273/2020)

On 31 May 2020 sometime before 2.59 p.m., the Deceased was riding his motorcycle along Serangoon Road on lane 3 of 4-lanes road when he suddenly lost control of his motorcycle, which veered to the left and collided onto the road kerb by the left side of the road and landed at the bus stop at the said location. Deceased was conveyed to TTSH where he succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced dead at CGH at 3.44pm on the same day.

While the motor car was negotiating a left bend, the motor car lost control, mounted the left kerb before colliding onto a lamp post. The driver of the said motor car claimed that his steering wheel suddenly spun out of control causing him to veer to his left.
