

## Dear Mr Ong,

We have inspected the Insured Vehicle. Our preliminary findings revealed the cause of fire to be electrical. We found a faulty component inside the dashboard which could be from where the fire started. However, we are unable to determine if the component is part of the lorry or the mobile crane. Refer to the attached picture below.



We have asked Mr Su Tho, the service advisor at MAN for the parts diagram to identify the burnt component. However, he is requesting permission to dismantle the dashboard and relevant components to facilitate repair.

We have also spoken to Mr Ang, the manager at Tanglin Corporation who informed us that he wishes to have the Insured Vehicle repaired.

Kindly advise us on the next course of action.
