



13.	<p>(a)</p>  <p>Diagram 1.34</p> <p>Vehicle X – Turning right into the major road from a minor road with a “stop” line/“stop” sign at the junction adjoining the major road</p> <p>Vehicle Y – Moving straight ahead on the major road from the left</p>	<p>Reason(s): Driver Y on the major road has right of way, but should keep a lookout for vehicles turning into the major road from an adjoining minor road. Driver Y should also take evasive action to avoid a collision. Driver X turning right from a minor road should stop at the “stop” line/“stop” sign to give way to traffic approaching from both sides/directions of the major road.³⁸</p>	80	20
