Hi Jaslin

As I mentioned, my vehicle was not damaged at all, because only my tire rubbed against the side of the other car (SGX6309L). So there was no need to take a photo of my own car.

But I did take a photo of the other car.

I did not report the accident to the police because a) There was no damage to any public property b) Nobody was hurt. It was a minor accident that any insurance company should be able to handle on a routine basis.

I attach the photo I took of the damage to the other car.

I also attach my account of the accident.

The other car only provided the camera footage of the moment of the accident which shows my tire rubbing against that car. But it is critical to obtain the footage from the other car for the one minute BEFORE the accident took place.

It will clearly show that the other car came from behind and tried to overtake me when I was turning into a one-lane road. The driver thought it was two lane. That is the first thing he said to me when he came out. There was nothing wrong with him - no injury whatsoever. His medical claims are all invented - I think he views this as an opportunity to make money. I believe AIG requested camera footage from the other car for the minute BEFORE the accident, but the other car declined to provide that footage - surely because the driver knows it would show that he was in the wrong.

I tried to get the footage from the petrol station camera, but they said they can only release this if requested by the police. I don't even know if they have it now because they keep it for about 6 months

I hope you can resolve this without submitting to the other driver's ridiculous claim.
