4 The Magistrate inquiring into your complaint may do any of the followings:

- a. Order Police to investigate if he is of the view that further inquiry is necessary.
- b. Order all parties to attend mediation and/or a case conference.
- c. Dismiss the complaint if it is without basis or if it is a civil matter or does not disclose an offence punishable by law. Your complaint may also be dismissed if you were referred to mediation and failed to attend.

5 It is an offence under section 181 of the Penal Code to make a false statement on oath to a Magistrate which carries mandatory imprisonment for up to 3 years and a fine.

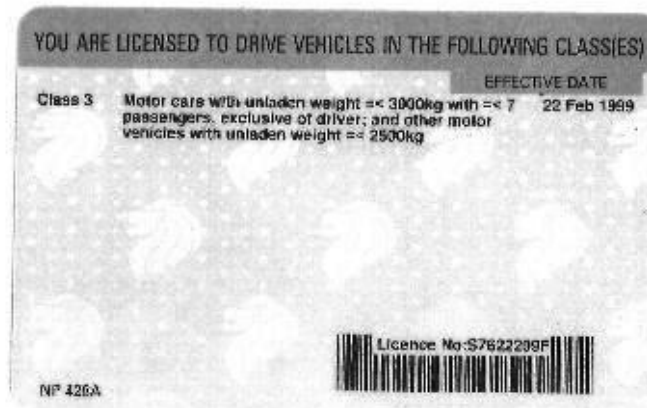
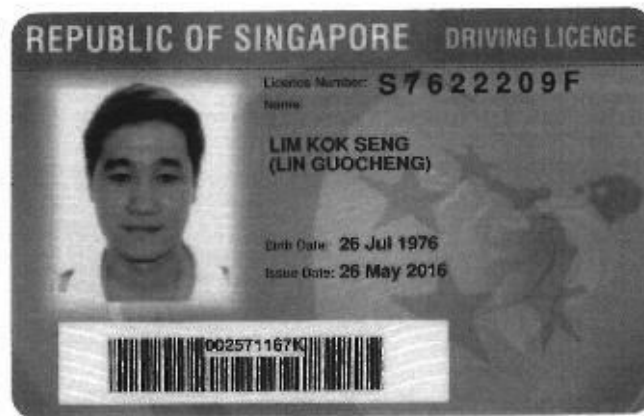
