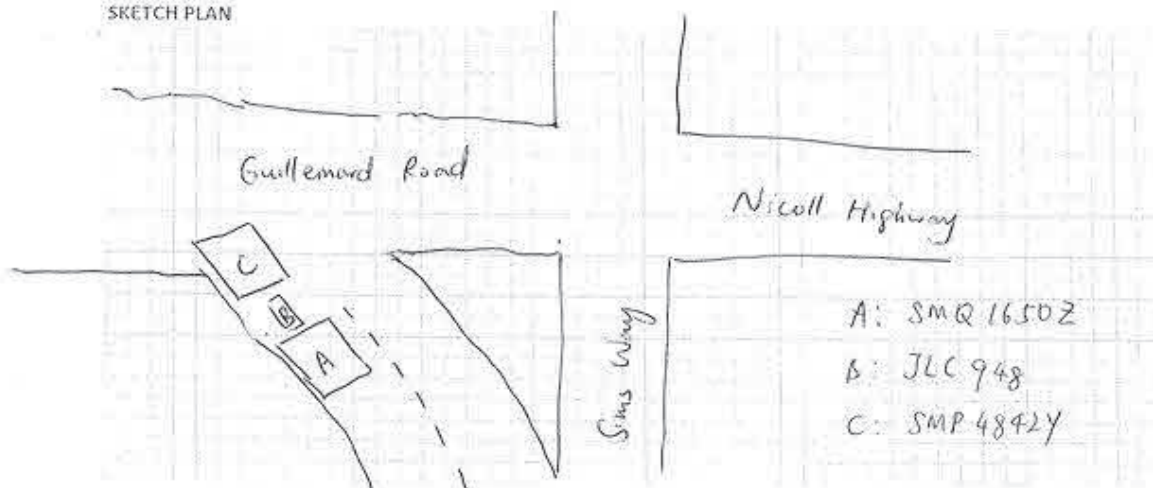

DESCRIBE CIRCUMSTANCES OF THE ACCIDENT

On 13 May 2021, around 6:07pm, I ~~was~~ was driving in Vehicle A (plate no# SMQ1650Z) along Sims Way and taking the slip road for turning into Guillemard Road. I had kept a safe distance with the motorcycle (Vehicle B, plate# JLC948) in front of me (coming from my side and turned into the space in front of me) while checking the traffic coming straight from Nicoll Highway direction ~~from~~ at my right.

The first car at the slip road (Vehicle C) (plate# SMP4842Y) started moving followed by the motorcycle. I turned my head to the right to carry out a last check in order to reaffirm that the traffic from Nicoll Highway was clear. I applied a light acceleration after the reaffirmation and soon realized that the first car (Vehicle C) and the motorcycle (Vehicle B) stopped abruptly in front of me. Despite the attempt of applying e-brake, the distance remained was too short for me to come to a complete stop, and this resulted in a light knock at the back of the motorcycle (B).

The motorcycle was pushed forward slightly as the result of sudden impact and the motorcyclist lost balance and fell onto the ground at his right. I immediately came out from the car to check his condition and informed SCDF. ~~SCDF~~ The motorist was alert and responsive. About 5 mins later, SCDF came and performed a check on the ~~motorist~~ motorist, everything was normal except minor abrasions at right knee and chin area. The motorist himself decided not to be conveyed to the ARE for further examination. After exchanging particulars for potential insurance.

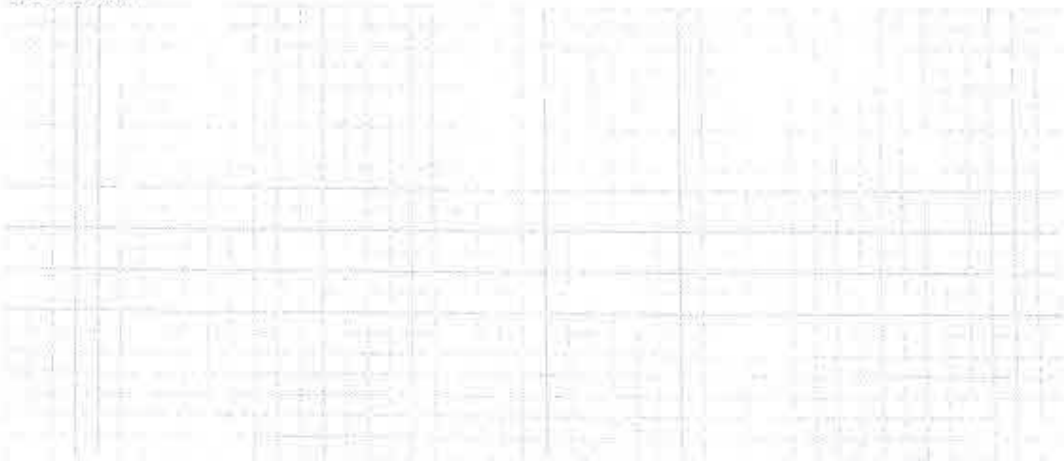

claim, the motorist left the accident scene around 7pm. I and vehicle C had also left the scene around 7:05pm. I called the motorist to follow up on his well being at around 10pm. The motorist responded that he was alright and was given some medicines and 7 days MC.

No damage was observed on Vehicle C, some minor scratches was observed with the motorcycle (B) and minor damage was observed with my vehicle (A). After reviewing the dashcam footage of my vehicle it was because vehicle C had a misjudgement of last car coming from Nicoll Highway before fitting into the main road. He stopped abruptly and being stagnant for ~~extended~~ short period of time without resuming his movement. This caused the motorcycle to also stop ~~near~~ abruptly. This incident should not have happened if Vehicle C did not stop abruptly and moving in graceful way.

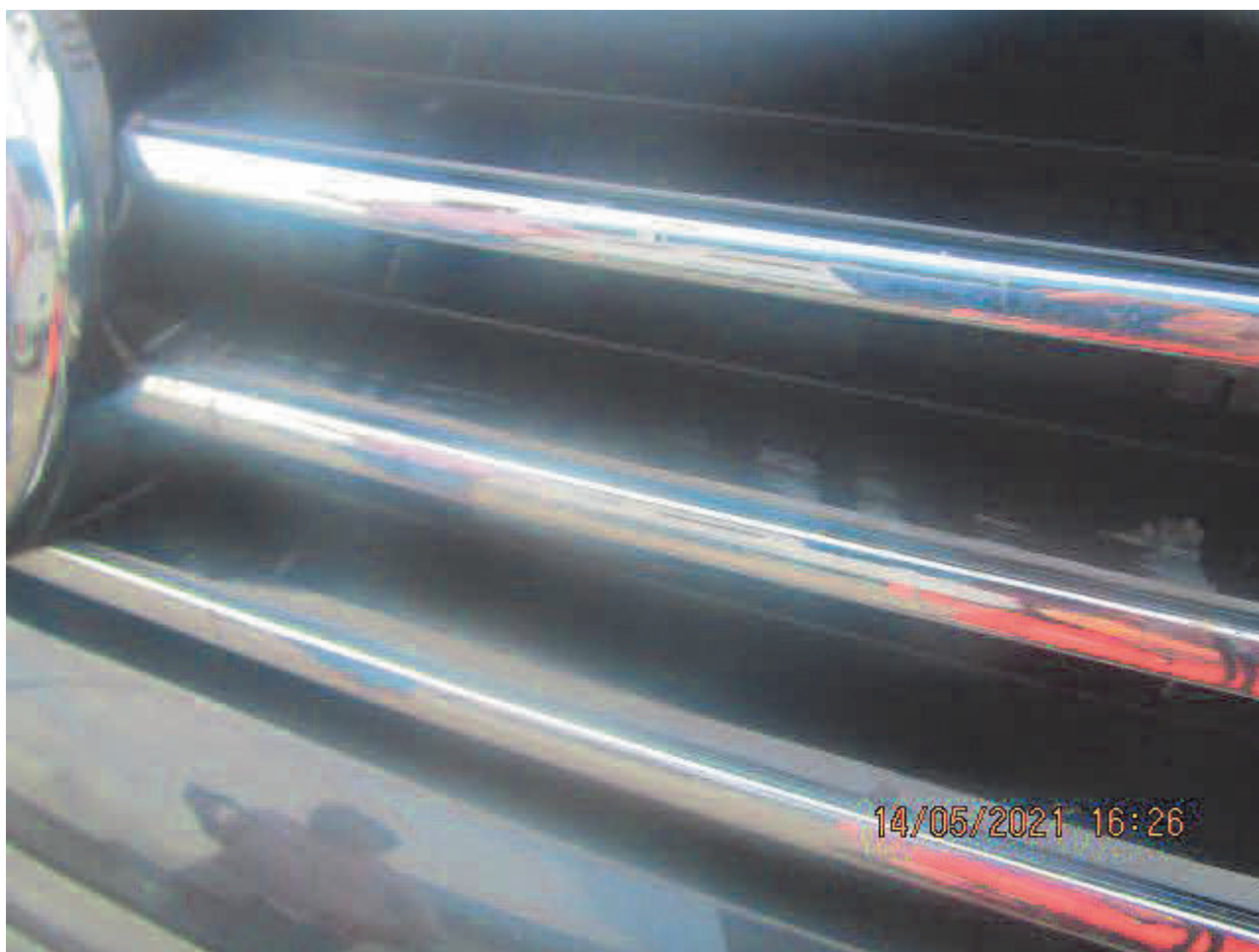
