STATEMENT OF CLAIM

- 1. The Plaintiff was at all material times the owner of motor vehicle bearing registration number SJL 7274Z (hereinafter referred to as "the Plaintiff's motor vehicle") which was driven by one, Muhamad Aminurrashid Bin Imran (hereinafter referred to as "Muhamad").
- 2. The Defendant was at all material times the rider and owner of motorcycle bearing registration no. FBJ 5105Y (hereinafter referred to as "Defendant's motorcycle").
- 3. On the 8th day of December 2018 at or about 2120 hours, the Plaintiff's motor vehicle was travelling along Woodlands Avenue 6 (hereinafter referred to as "the said road") and was making a u turn along the said road suddenly and without warning, the Defendant's motorcycle which was travelling behind the Plaintiff's motor vehicle collided into the right side of the Plaintiff's motor vehicle (the Accident). As a result, the Plaintiff suffered loss and damages.
- 4. The said collision was caused solely or contributed to by the negligence of the Defendant in the riding, management and control of the Defendant's motorcycle.

PARTICULARS OF NEGLIGENCE OF THE DEFENDANT

- a. Failing to keep any or any proper look-out for traffic or to have any or any sufficient regard for other vehicles;
- b. Failing to apply his brakes in time or at all so as to avoid the said collision;
- c. Failing to observe the presence of the Plaintiff's motor vehicle;

- d. Failing to observe basic traffic rules;
- e. Failing to manage or control of Defendant's motorcycle so as to avoid the said collision;
- f. Failing to exercise prudence and care in the driving, use and management of the Defendant's motorcycle;
- g. Failing to have any or any sufficient control over the Defendant's motorcycle;
- h. Driving at an excessive speed in the circumstances;
- Driving without due care and attention and without due regard for the safety of other road users;
- i. Failing to keep a safe following distance from the Plaintiff's motor vehicle;
- k. Colliding into the rear of the Plaintiff's motor vehicle;
- 1. In so far as may be necessary, the Plaintiff will rely upon the doctrine of res ipsa loquitur.
- 5. By reason of the negligence of the Defendant, the Plaintiff has sustained injuries and has endured pain and has been put to loss and expenses.
- 6. By reason of the matters aforesaid, the Plaintiff has suffered loss and damage.

i. Cost of Repairs \$ 5,300.00

ii. Loss of use (8 days x \$120.00) \$ 960.00
