We refer to the above matter.

Third party reported that he was driving along Sengkang West Way road and wanted to turn left into Fernvale Road. He was at extreme left lane and suddenly OI filtered onto his lane and grazed onto third party front right portion.

OI reported that he signal left and his car was already filtering into small lane. Third party taxi accelerated and hit onto OI rear side.

We have uploaded a copy of third party video in Merimen for your easy reference. From third party video footage, we observe that our insured has signalled his intention to change lane and third party who was driving behind speed up resulting in the collision. We are of the view that third party driver is proximate cause of collision.

In view of this, we are intending to reject third party claim.
