### **Incident Involving SKQ 4973X and Blue taxi SHD 4826S on 29.10.2021 Your ref CC4/AIG21011135/ps3**

I have just today received your letter dated 3rd November regarding the above incident. I notice the date because I only received it today, this afternoon of the 9th November, so either you did not post it on the 3rd or you are playing tricks as you give me 5 days to reply!!!! What is this nonsense?!

I did not make a report as I considered this not a major enough incident to involve the police or the insurance. However, I did come home and write my own report, while it was fresh in my mind, which I will attach with this letter. As you will see I had just picked up my friend who was a witness to the whole thing (copied herewith) and when she got out of the car and started taking photos, the taxi driver quickly got in his cab and like snow in the sun he vanished, without exchanging even names, let alone insurance or anything else. He obviously knew he was in the wrong! Until he saw I had a witness he was quite aggressive as you can see from the photograph, attack being the best form of defense I suppose.

That is also why I did not make a report as it would mean tracking him down although I knew it was 100% his fault, and looking at the damage to my car I realised it would be cheaper and easier to just get it fixed - a simple polish. I also did not want to trouble my friend to be a witness, have her make a report and then trace this unco-operative driver who ran off without so much as giving me his name.

You can see from the damage to my car that his taxi came from behind/side and hit me. How could I have hit him with the back side of my car?! I had just turned out from Taman Nakhoda onto Holland road and he just came out of nowhere and hit me - must have been looking at his phone or GPS or something I assume.

I have a friend's 95th birthday party tomorrow lunchtime and am making her a cake in the morning, however, I will go to make a report at the police station tomorrow afternoon, which is the soonest opportunity I can do it. This is my husband's car but he has been stuck in China for 18 months now so I drive it now and then to keep it moving.

I attach herewith my statement written on the day and we both have photographs of the incident.

I hope this will be the end of the matter.
