Dear Mr Tan

The Items indicated "no photo showing damage" in our survey report are parts that have no photos depicting the damage. We have reviewed all the photos provided and maintain this position. However, these same parts are found in the supplier invoice that the workshop had provided. Even though they have purchased these parts, we are of the view these parts should be removed due to the lack of photos as we do not know if these parts are indeed damaged and even if damaged, whether they are related to this incident.

Regarding the days claimed, our recommendation of 10 days is purely for the working days to reasonably carry out the repair. It does not include weekends and PH, if any. The last item delivered was 24 Nov 2021. The part delivered was "grommet washer tank rubber". We are of the view that without this part, the vehicle is driveable and can return to the workshop to fit once the part arrive. However, it is noted that the second last item delivered was "electrical wiring harness" and it was delivered 4 days before 24 Nov 2021. Without this wiring harness, the vehicle will not be able to start. It would not be unusual for this wiring harness to be not readily available. Often, this wiring harness needs to indent from manufacturer, and this can take some time. Overall, the number of claimed for downtime pending parts arrival is reasonable.

For the excess sum of \$1,284.00, it is claimable. This amount is determined by the owner's insurer at the policy inception date and is payable by the owner making an own damage claim to his insurer. Recovery of this paid excess amount is justified.

For the battery, the 50% is not claimable as this is the "portion" of the battery "used" by the owner before this incident. Such depreciation is applicable for wear and tear items like battery and tyres. By reimbursing this 50% to the owner, he would effectively have a 100% lifespan battery, which would not be fair given that the battery at the time of incident was a used battery and less than 100% lifespan at time of accident.

2) Per Para 5b of your Inspection Report, LKK's view is that the estimated period of repair should be 10 days. However, the insurers have informed us that the period of repair lasted for 4 months due to a shortage of spare parts. May I check if LKK views the delay as being reasonable? I.e. is it reasonably possible for shortage of spare parts to have caused a delay from 10 days to 4 months given the types of parts, and period? I have attached the suppliers' invoice provided by the insurers which lists the exact spare part, and when they were delivered. I note that the part that

arrived the latest was the "GROMMET – Washer Tonic Rubber" which was delivered on 24 November 2021, 4 months after the vehicle was first sent to the workshop.
