On the above-mention date, time and location, I was riding my Power Assisted Bicycle/electric bicycle, bearing registration number CC25, along the single lane two-way service road within the open car park heading towards the gantry exit at Yishun Avenue 5.

I had just completed a food order delivery at Block 710 and had turned left from behind the block onto the main straight service road towards Yishun Avenue 5.

Just as I passing Block 709, suddenly a vehicle, later established as Strides SMRT taxi bearing registration number SHB5931A, suddenly drove out of a car park lot, later established as lot number 540, from my front left side directly ahead of my path.

As it was too sudden and too close, I was unable to react at all to serve away or brake even. The front of my electric bicycle then collided onto the right front of this taxi and I was thrown off my bicycle, flying over the front of the taxi to land on the other side of the taxi on the road. It happened so fast that I can't even recall how I landed on the road.

Immediately after the accident, I was stunned and in shock. I found that I was bleeding at my left chin and left shin, and parts of my body felt numb. My electric bicycle was lying on the road on the front right of the taxi and my personal items were all strewn on the ground. I picked up my mobile phone which apparently had flew out of the bicycle holder to land on the road, damaging the device itself.

The taxi driver remained inside his vehicle during this time and I was extremely emotional. I then banged on the front bonnet of the taxi and waited for him to come out. The taxi driver upon alighting, did not offer any apologies nor render any aid to me at all. He kept mumbling that he stopped already and that he had a passenger aboard.

Since the taxi driver, a grey haired elderly Chinese man, didn't offer me any aid at all, I called 995 to request for an ambulance and the police to scene.

I approached the left rear passenger and met with the male Chinese passenger and obtained his particulars as Mr Ang Poh Lim with his mobile number: 97463096. He mentioned that the taxi driver is his regular driver and that he was on his way to work. He was unsure how the accident happened and said he was rushing to work so he left shortly.

During this time, another delivery rider stopped to help remove my bicycle from the ground and picked up my items for me.

I asked for the taxi driver's licence to gather his particulars but he refused to provide me his details.

As he was unreasonable and unapologetic for causing this accident, and I was still in shock from the accident, I did not continue to speak with him and waited for the ambulance and police to arrive.

Upon arrival of the ambulance, the paramedics checked and treated my wounds. The paramedic mentioned that at the time, since I did not appear to sustain any fractures, I ought to seek further medical treatment on my own later. While being treated by the paramedic who asked whether I was wearing a helmet at the time of the accident because while waiting the ambulance to arrive, I had taken off me helmet and kept it inside my bicycle bag, the taxi driver overheard and accused me of

not wearing my bicycle helmet. I was totally frustrated with him at the time but had no strength to argue with him.

The Traffic Police arrived shortly and after concluding their investigations on site, provided me with the case details and advised to lodge a police report later.

I proceeded to the nearby 24-hour clinic at Block 701A but upon speaking with the nurse, was advised that due to motor accidents, the in-house doctor would definitely refer me to hospital later. As just last week I had to bring my spouse for medical treatment for a bad bout of flu and difficulty breathing and had to wait the whole afternoon and evening there despite her medical emergency, I decided not to go to the hospital then but to seek medical treatment later in the morning and proceeded back to attend to my wounds before resting.

I discovered that I sustained the following injuries due to the accident:

1. A large abrasion on my left chin.
2. Two long scratches, abrasions from my wrist to elbow and bruising on my left forearm.
3. A slight cut above my left knee.
4. Several cuts on left shin above my ankle.
5. Bruising on my right inner forearm.
6. Small cut and bruise on my right hand below my thumb.
7. Right palm painful.
8. Right wrist stiff and painful.
9. Neck and back pain.

During a brief check of my electric bicycle and personal items, I discovered the following damaged:

1. Both mirrors scratched badly and loose.
2. Both brake levers scratched and damaged.
3. Right brake lever totally bent out of shape.
4. Either one or both brake discs appeared warped.
5. The front stem and front wheel fork assembly appears damaged and wobbly.
6. My mobile device, iPhone 13 Pro, was scratched deeply on the top and on one of the rear lenses.
7. My spectacles, Oakley with bifocal lenses, had both lenses clipped.

This morning, I proceeded to the nearby medical clinic, Viva Medical Group, for further medical treatment.

I further discovered that I felt further pain during my medical examination, namely:

1. Right back of my neck was tender and stiff.
2. Lower right back was stiff and painful.
3. Right ankle though not swollen felt weak and painful when thudded against the floor while walking to the clinic.

The doctor advised that most of my other injuries were muscular strains and to proceed back for further treatment if the injuries do not recover properly. I was given seven days of medical leave.

Thus, I am lodging this report as the taxi driver had caused this accident which resulted in me to sustain injuries and damage to my electric bicycle and personal items.
