



1. Ms Lee was the front seat passenger in a car when it was hit at high speed at the rear on the passenger side on 8 Oct 2022 at 10.30pm. She sustained severe neck, back and left shoulder pain after the accident.
2. She saw me today as her pain has become worse. On examination, her neck is tight with soreness over the left upper trapezius. ROM of the cervical spine was limited especially for rotation. Her left shoulder is tender over the left deltoid and her lumbar area was stiff with erector spine tightness. She is neurologically intact. Dx are grade 2 cervical whiplash, severe lumbar strain and left shoulder strain.
3. She has been given 3 days of medical leave and treated conservatively with Arcoxia. She is still under follow-up.
