- Mr Yeo was the driver of a car when it was hit at high speed at the rear on the passenger side on 8 Oct 2022 at 10.30pm. He sustained severe neck, back pain after the accident.
- He saw me today as his pain has become worse. On examination, his neck is tight with soreness over both upper trapezius. ROM of the cervical spine was limited especially for rotation and flexion. His lumbar area was stiff with erector spine tightness. He is neurologically intact. Dx are grade 2 cervical whiplash, severe lumbar strain.
- He has been given 3 days of medical leave and treated conservatively with Arcoxia. He is still under follow-up.
