We are instructed by the abovenamed Claimant, who is our client, to claim damages against you in connection with a road traffic accident on 17th February 2022 at about 1130 hours along Lower Delta Road involving our client who was the rider of vehicle bearing registration number FBR 7685J and motor vehicle bearing registration number SMM 1048J driven by you/your authorized driver.

We are instructed that the accident was caused by the/your negligence of your authorized driver. As a result of the accident, our client suffered personal injuries. His injuries are set out in the medical report annexed to this letter. Our client has been put to loss and expenses, particulars of which are as follows:

 - Peroneal brevis tendinosis
 - Subacute/chronic non-union navicular fracture
 - Early degenerative changes at the posterior subtalar joint
 - May experience right ankle pain and/or instability in the long run and may affect his daily life and work
 - 5% permanent incapacity
 - May require future surgical intervention
