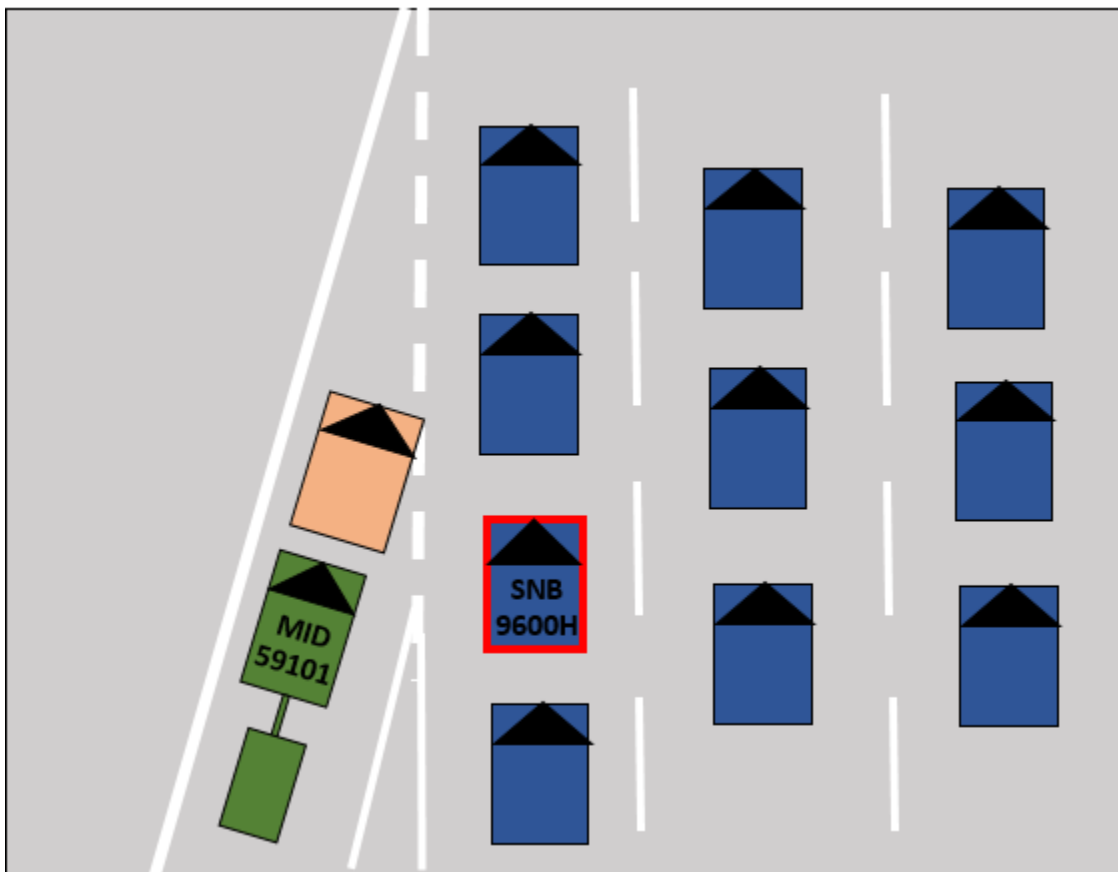


Figure 1A: Schematic Diagram

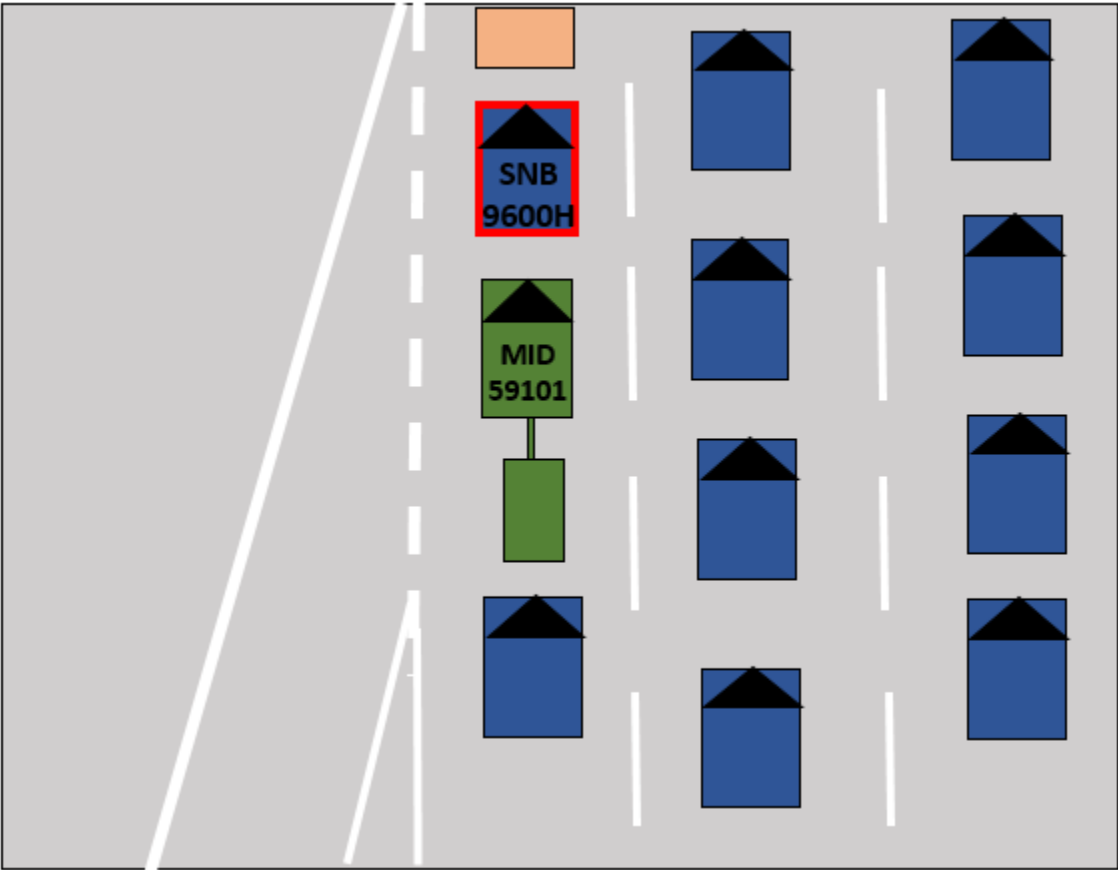


Figure 1B: Schematic Diagram

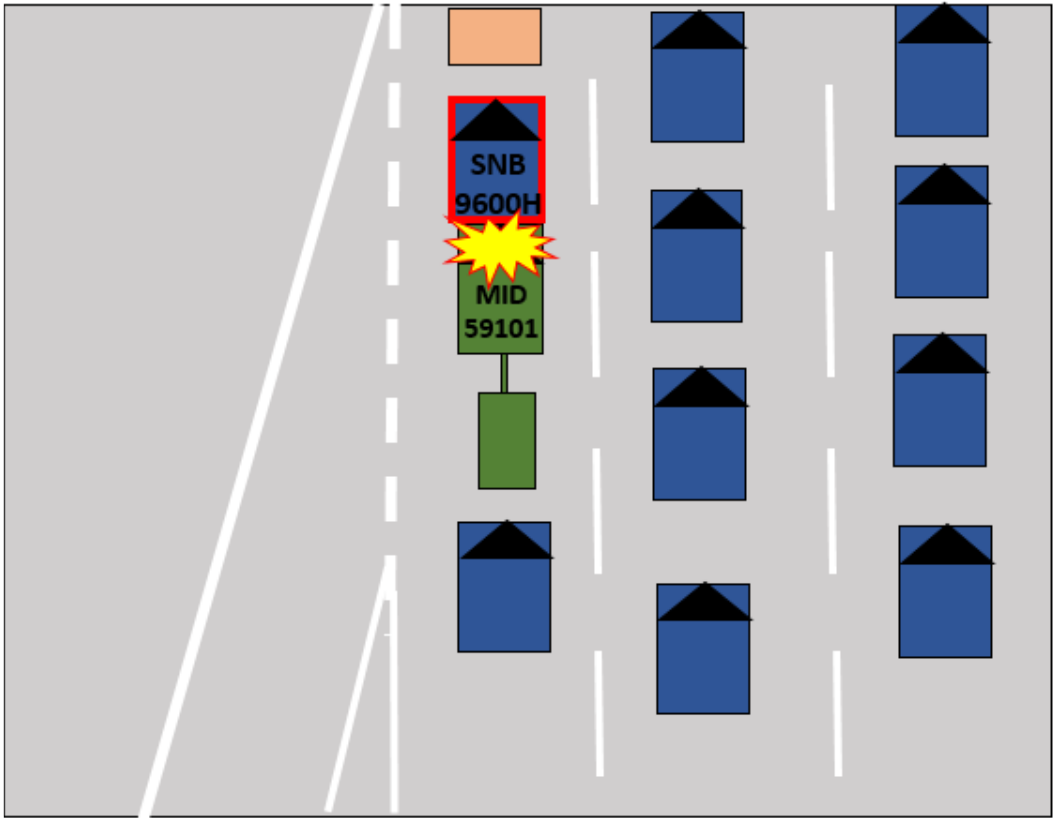


Figure 1C: Schematic Diagram

<p>I, CPL DANIAL, was the driver of the MB190, MID59101. At that time 1030, I had an accident with another civilian car (SNB9600H) ast after Clementi Avenue 6, Exit 6. A VCom was present in the vehicle which was LCP XUAN HAO and our task to bring the vehicle from Clementi Camp to Pasir Laba Camp to return the vehicle.</p> <p>While on the road, there was traffic congestion entering PIE making it very challenging to manage as my vehicle had a trailer. As I was driving, the vehicles ahead were moving and breaking continuously to the point where I was not able to know what was going on ahead. I drove slowly around 30km/h when suddenly, the vehicle in front of me jam braked to the point where I couldn't react fast enough. I did E-Brake my vehicle but it hit the rear of the civilian vehicle still. After the collision, we pulled over to the side of the road shoulder.</p> <p>After pulling over, we exchanged details and took photos of all the damages. Damages were minor scratches, there were no injuries or casualties. The civilian driver was not able to wait any longer as he had something on and left the scene while we were waiting for our PLC MTLNE officer to come down and investigate the matter.</p> <p>At around 1145hrs, a transport officer came to the scene and began investigating the matter. I was questioned as to what and how it had happened so I answered truthfully and coordinated with the investigation officer. After the investigation, the PLC Node Commander instructed us to return the vehicle back to MTLNE for further investigating and maintenance.</p> <p>To summarize, as there were minor damages to the vehicle, it was not an issue of tailgating, but more of slow reaction time. I tried my best to E-Brake but was not able to stop in time due to the weight of the vehicle with the trailer on, thus hitting the rear of the vehicle in front of me.</p>

<p>I was the vehicle commander for CPL DANIAL. At 10.15am, CPL DANIAL and I moved off from Clementi Camp towards Pasir Laba Camp in a GRS with carplate MID59109, with a vehicle with 2 cubic personnel driving in front of us and escorting us. At about 10.20am, after Clementi Avenue 6 Exit 6, I noticed that there were vehicles in front of ours slowing down and speeding up abruptly, and CPL DANIAL adjusted his speed accordingly while maintaining a safe distance from the car in front. Suddenly, the vehicle in front of ours, carplate no.SNB9600H performed an emergency brake and I told CPL DANIAL to stop and he did try. CPL DANIAL could not stop the vehicle in time as he was slow in reaction time, and the front of our GRS bumped into the rear of the civilian car sustained minor damages.</p> <p>Upon both vehicles pulling over to the side of the road, CPL DANIAL and the civilian driver exchanged numbers. The civilian driver said that the insurance would be claimed against the driver and then said he had to leave for an urgent work-related matter and as such, drove off after 5-10 minutes. The 2 cubic personnel stopped over as well, contacted the MT LINE and waited with us at the side of the road.</p> <p>By 1200pm, both LTA and the MT Line had arrived to the site of the accident. LTA Jayen from the MT LINE took down both mine and CPL DANIAL'S numbers and NRIC, and subsequently informed us to make a police report. At about 1pm, we were given the green light by the Node Commander to drive back to Pasir Laba Camp for maintenance purposes. At 1.30pm, we returned to Pasir Laba Camp.</p>
