SKETCH PLAN

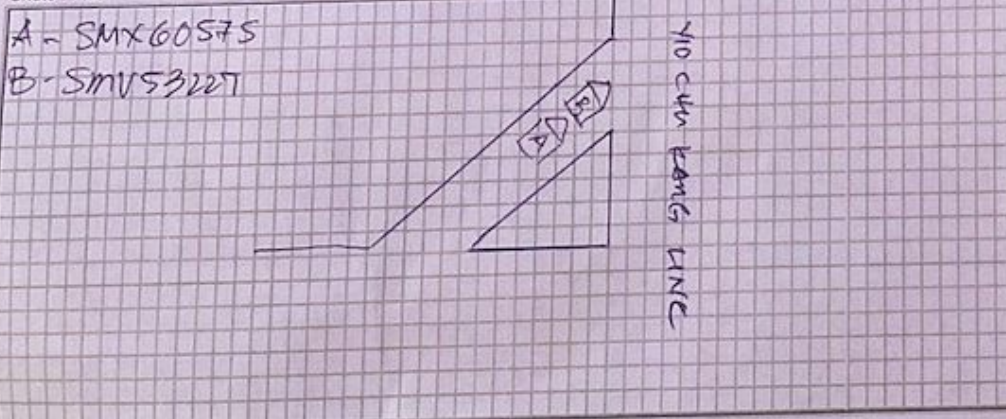
