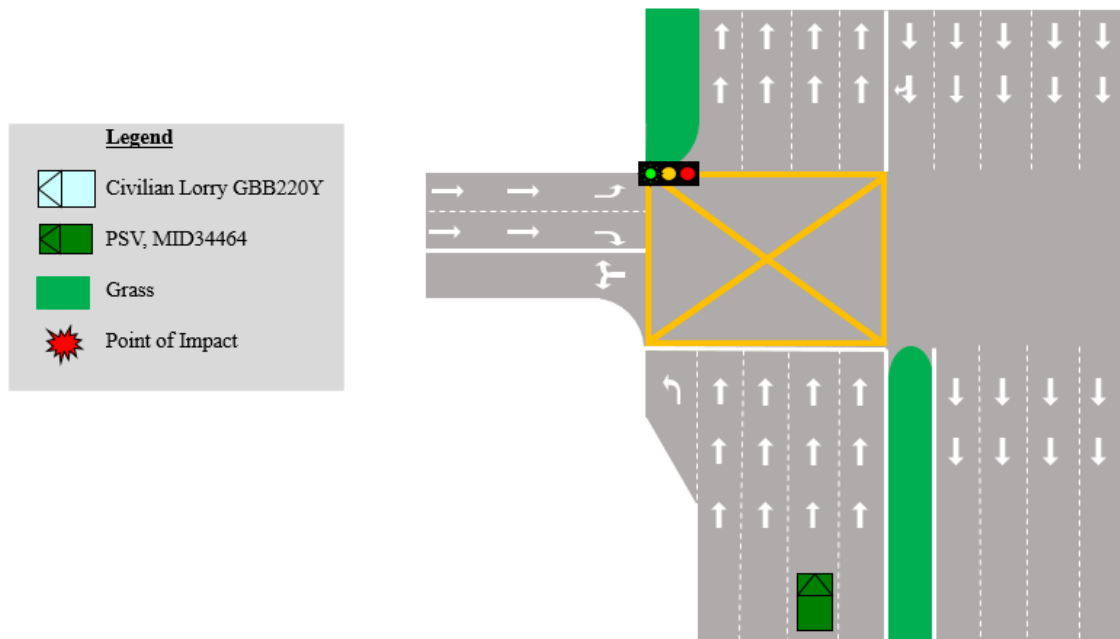


Figure 1A: Schematic Diagram

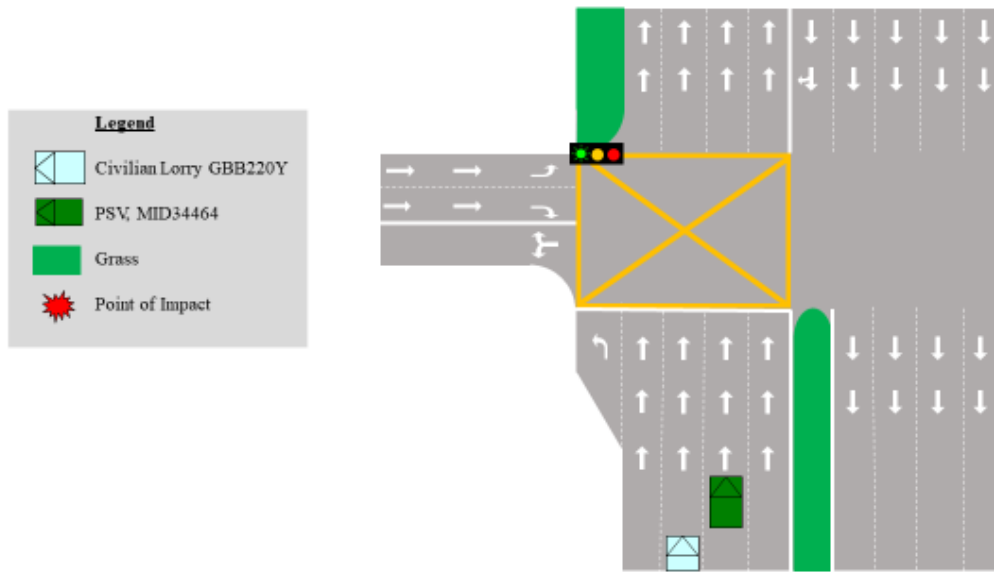


Figure 1B: Schematic Diagram

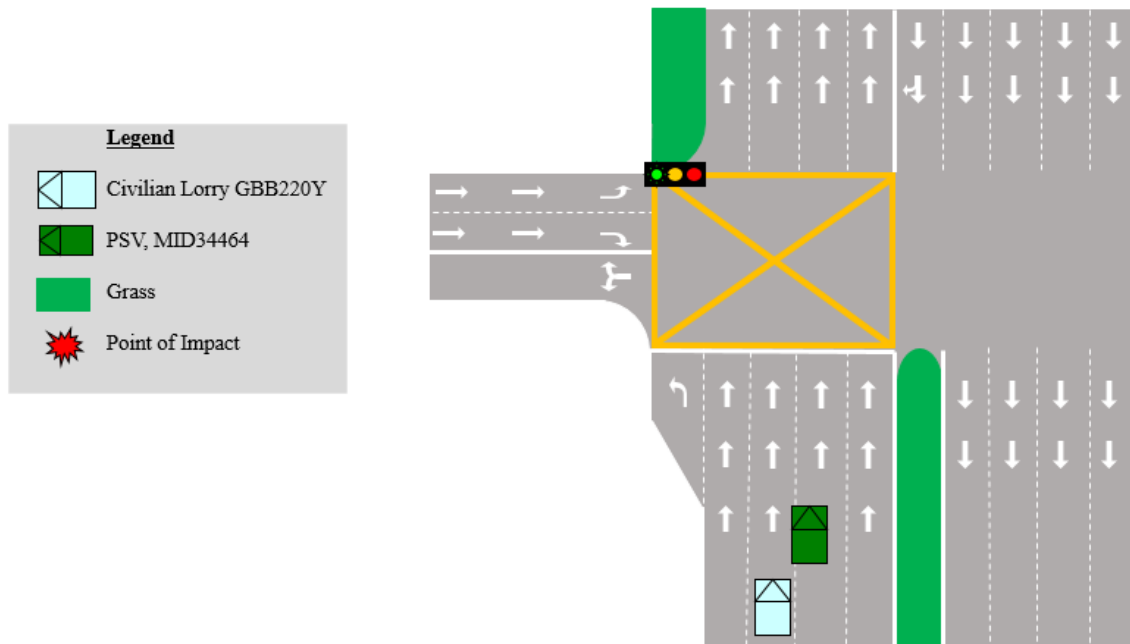


Figure 1C: Schematic Diagram

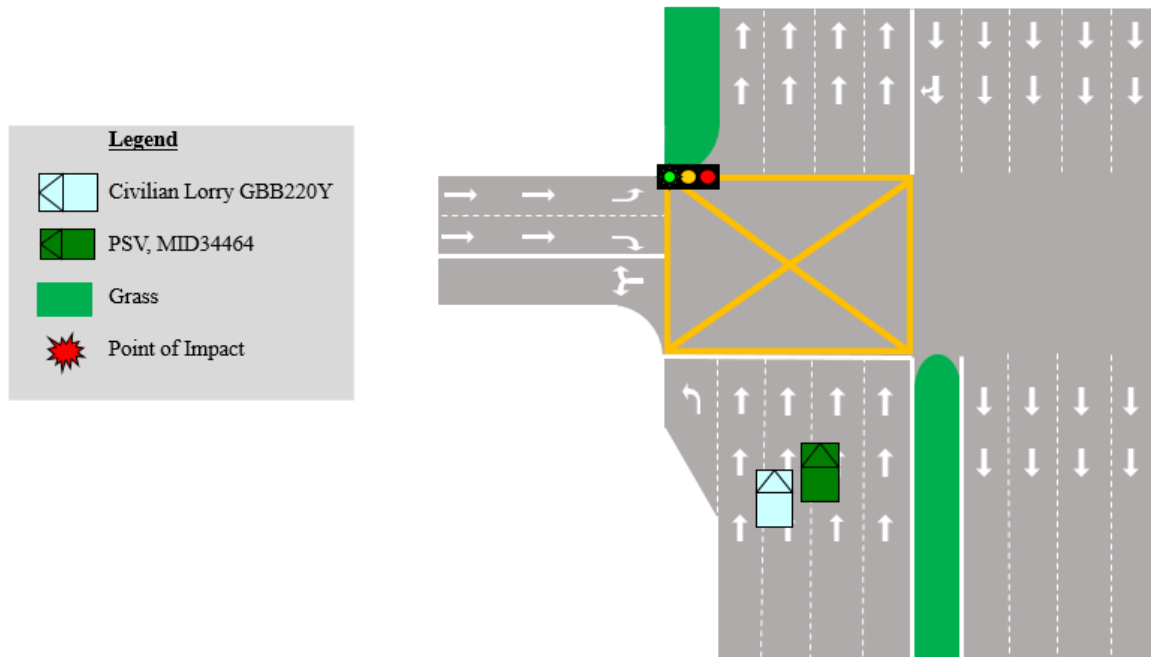


Figure 1D: Schematic Diagram

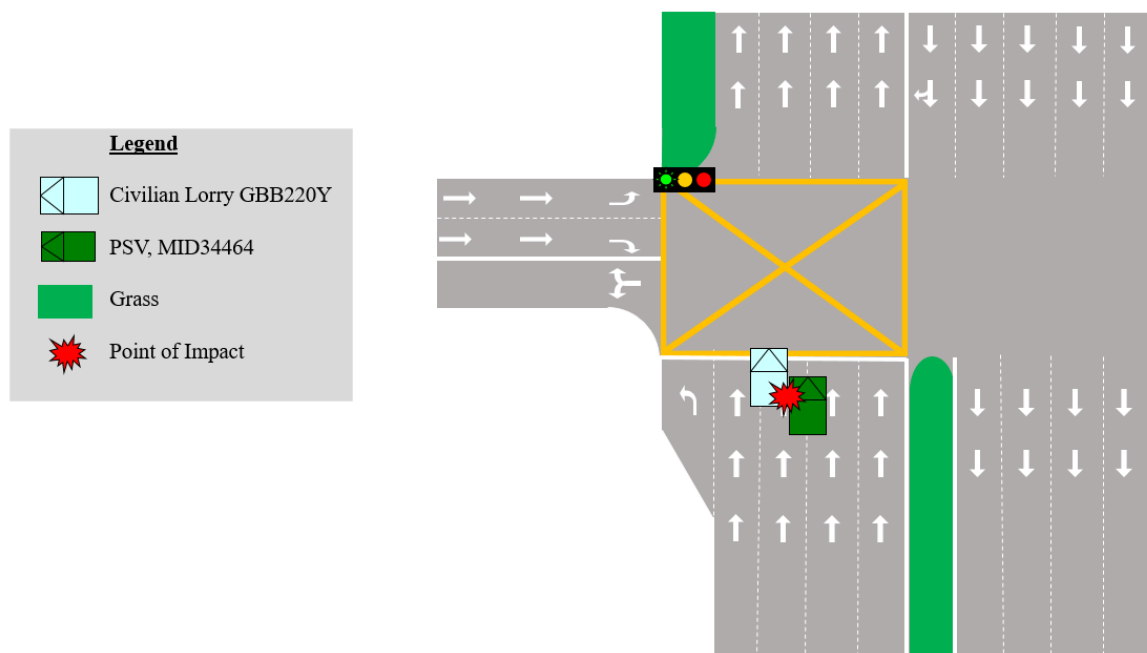


Figure 1E: Schematic Diagram

<p>On 160323, I was [REDACTED] at Jurong Island as a [REDACTED] TO using MIO 34464. As per SOP, myself and the security troopers from [REDACTED] did not bring any handphones with us and were kept at FOB. We went out [REDACTED] as per usual and I had sufficient rest before beginning the patrol. At 0015 hrs, along Jurong Island Highway, I was traveling on the second lane at a safe speed at between 50-60 km/h and I was humming to a song the music in the background. I then lost concentration for a few seconds and did not maintain my lane discipline. The vehicle then went into the lane on the left. I only realise the issue when my VC, 3SS IVAN LEE, alerted me. However as the incoming civilian vehicle, 6BB220Y, was too fast and close to my vehicle vehicle, I could not avoid the collision in time. The left front of my vehicle were scratched and the right rear body panel of the civilian vehicle were dented. Upon the collision, the vehicle commander reported the incident through the walkie talkie that he had. I immediately tried to slow down to come to a stop at the side of the road. However, the civilian vehicle continued to drive off after impact and the VC asked me to follow him to ensure his safety and I did as instructed. While I followed him, the troopers were still reporting the incident back to FOB. The civilian vehicle then turned into an open parking area at the next junction and parked. We then dismounted and informed the civilian driver of the incident that had occurred minutes ago.</p>

<p>On 160323 at around 0010hrs, I, 3SG Ivan Lee Zhen Wei, was doing the [REDACTED] TO, PTE ARASTU in MID 34464.</p> <p>We finished [REDACTED] and were heading back to FOB. When we were heading for a u-turn to FOB, I noticed the civilian vehicle on the left of the PSV as I was looking out the left window. As the civilian vehicle drove past us, I realized that the PSV was slowly turning left into lane 3. There was very little time for me to react but I tried to alert PTE ARASTU by raising my voice, "Woah woah woah" but at that point the PSV already came into contact with the civilian driver.</p> <p>When the incident happened, we stopped at the side but the civilian vehicle kept driving and showed no signs of stopping. Thus, to ensure the civilian driver was aware I instructed PTE ARASTU to follow him and honk so that we could inform him of the incident. Eventually we got down and talked to him about it. I knew about vehicle incident procedure and we did stop for a while but I thought there was a need to ensure the relevant parties involved in the case must stop together so I gave the instruction to PTE ARASTU to follow.</p> <p>After that, we contacted our CSM, 3WO Toby to assess the situation. When 3WO Toby arrived, he asked me and PTE ARASTU what happened. And I told him what happened. Which was that I realized that the PSV was slowly turning into the other vehicle. I tried to stop it but it was too late. But I did not suspect him of sleeping as he was humming to the music played on the speaker a few seconds before the incident took place.</p> <p> </p>
