**CAR ACCIDENT INVOLVING SGD 1666T AND SLR 4481G ON 7TH APRIL 2023,
17:30 HOURS ALONG/AT SERVICE ROAD BESIDES MULTI STOREY CARPARK
OF BLOCK 160A TECK WHYE LANE.**

I, LAU Xian Ming Mr. (NRIC S8813143F) drove car SGD1666T which belongs to my father-in-law KWAN Seng Fan Mr. (NRIC S0133627D) on 7th April 2023 from home to Teck Whye area with my wife. I drove along Jalan Teck Whye Lane and entered car park next to block 160A around 5:30pm and stopped the car close to the side (Picture 1 shows location and Picture 2 shows where our car stopped) on the 2-way driveway between block 160A and block 163 at the sheltered area with hazard lights on, to drop my wife off as it was still drizzling. When we arrived, there was no vehicle in sight around us.

My wife, who was sitting by the right rear passenger door was just opening the car door, when suddenly she felt the impact and heard a loud noise, and the car door swung back to close. My wife and I were stunned for a moment. We finally regained our composure and got out of the car to investigate. We realized that our car was involved in an accident with another car SLR4481G. My wife and I were alarmed to realize how close this car was to our car at the time that my wife was opening the car door. It appeared that the driver of this car SLR4481G was recklessly trying to overtake, and came so close that my wife could have been seriously injured if she had fully opened the car door or stepped out a moment sooner. Picture 3 shows there was lot of space between the left side of our car and the 2-way driveway. Picture 4 shows that even if our car door was fully open, it doesn't cross the division line. And yet the driver of car SLR4481G failed in his lookout and recklessly manoeuvred his car so close, so furious as he overtook the stationary car at a sheltered area with hazard lights on. The driver admitted he was rushing to deliver something to someone in that vicinity, and did not have the time to settle the matter then with us when we approached him.

It was fortunate that my wife was uninjured, just a little shocked. If not, I would be suing the driver for causing involuntary hurt to my wife. Since there is no serious damage to our car, I decided not to pursue the matter. Now I came to realize that this driver instead of admitting his fault for reckless driving, is trying to make a false claim against me (or my father-in-law). I have no choice but to submit my statement to refute this claim.
