**FATAL ROAD TRAFFIC ACCIDENT ON 6 OCTOBER 2022 SOMETIME BEFORE 6.19 A.M.
ALONG PAN ISLAND EXPRESSWAY TOWARDS TUAS, 30 KM NEAR LAMPPOST 1481/2,
INVOLVING A MOTORCYCLE, FZ 9569 J & SAF AMBULANCE 34672 MID**

Please refer to the State Coroner's finding touching on the death of the late Mr Wan Hilmi Bin Noordin on the fatal road traffic accident that happened on 6 October 2022 sometime before 6.19 a.m. along Pan Island Expressway towards Tuas, 30 km marker, Singapore.

2. The State Coroner has decided not to hold an Inquiry pursuant to Section 25(2) of the Coroners Act 2010. The State Coroner returned his verdict as follows: **Wan Hilmi Bin Noordin, a 28-year-old male, Malay, Singapore Citizen, was pronounced dead on 6 October 2022 at National University Hospital ("NUH") after a traffic accident along Pan Island Expressway ("expressway") towards Jurong near the Bukit Batok Flyover at Lamp Post 1483. Mr Wan was riding his motorcycle bearing licence plate no. FZ 9569J ("motorcycle") at the time of the accident. The police were alerted to Mr Wan's accident at around 6.19 a.m. on 6 October 2022. Sometime before 6.19 a.m. on 6 October 2022, an SAF ambulance bearing licence plate no. 34672MID ("ambulance") was traveling straight along lane 3 of the expressway. At that time, Mr Wan was riding his motorcycle in lane 2 of the expressway and as he approached the ambulance he was seen veering to the left, which resulted in his motorcycle colliding into the rear left portion of the ambulance. While the driver of the ambulance ("driver") felt a thud at the rear of the ambulance, he did not suspect that anything was amiss as he did not notice anything in his side mirrors and rear view monitor. The driver perceived that the ambulance had travelled over a pothole due to similar experiences in the past. As such, the driver continued driving ambulance on the expressway. The driver only realised that the ambulance had been involved in an accident when he reached his destination and discovered that the**



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rear left portion of the ambulance was damaged. At the time of the accident, a taxi driver ("FIR caller") was traveling in lane 3 of the expressway behind the ambulance. The FIR caller explained that Mr Wan was riding his motorcycle in lane 2 of the expressway and after Mr Wan had overtaken his taxi he observed Mr Wan veering to the left resulting in the motorcycle colliding into the rear of the ambulance. The collision was captured by the FIR caller's in-vehicle camera. After the collision, the FIR caller observed that Mr Wan was lying on the road and called for an ambulance. Mr Wan was conveyed to NUH where it was noted that he had sustained, among other things, right subdural haematoma with mass effect and left midline shift. This injury was very severe and despite surgery and resuscitation, Mr Wan's condition continued to deteriorate. Mr Wan was pronounced dead at NUH on 6 October 2022 at 1.16 p.m. The Forensic Pathologist has certified Mr Wan's cause of death as Extensive Cranio-Cerebral and Facial Injuries consistent with being sustained in a road traffic accident. A toxicological analysis detected the presence of ethanol at a level consistent with antemortem consumption below the legal limit of driving in Singapore, fentanyl (medically used as a painkiller and anaesthetic) at a level within the usual therapeutic range, levetiracetam (medically used for the treatment of seizures) at a level within the usual therapeutic range, lignocaine (medically used for the treatment of arrhythmias and pain) at a level within the usual therapeutic range, midazolam (medically used as a sedative and for the treatment of seizures) at a level within the usual therapeutic range and hydroxymidazolam (metabolite of midazolam) in Mr Wan's post-mortem samples. The substances did not cause or contribute to Mr Wan's death. It has been clarified that it would have been unlikely that the level of ethanol would detected in Mr Wan's system would have had any bearing on his gait, reaction and judgment. The remaining detected substances were consistent with antemortem medical therapy rendered to Mr Wan. At the time of the accident, traffic flow was light, road surface was dry and the weather was clear. An inspection of the motorcycle was conducted but due to the extensive damage sustained it could not be ascertained whether there was any possible mechanical failure to the motorcycle which may have caused or contributed to the accident. Mr Wan's father stated that he believed that Mr Wan was traveling to work at the time of the accident. The father confirmed that Mr Wan did not have any pre-existing medical condition and was not taking any medication. The father explained that Mr Wan did not have any financial difficulties and did not display any suicidal tendencies. In the circumstances,



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there is no basis to suspect foul play. Mr Wan's death was an unfortunate traffic misadventure.

3. In view of the overall circumstances of the case and after consultation with the Attorney General's Chambers, Traffic Police is not taking any action against anyone involved in this accident.
